Milwaukee Servant Trip

Nordland will be participating in a servant trip through Serve Boldly and Green Lake Camp this summer! In 2019 we went to Denver, and this year we are headed to Milwaukee, Wisconsin! This trip is open to all youth who will have completed grades 8-12 this summer. And, of course, friends are welcome! There will also be other church groups from around the country who will be in Milwaukee with us. We will be traveling by 12-15 passenger vans.

What about our Milwaukee experience?

According to U.S. Census Bureau data, Milwaukee ranks second in poverty among the top 50 most populated cities in the United States, with 24.6% of the city living in poverty. Our ministry in the city seeks to respond to our neighbors in need by working with those who are already caring for the city. We will work alongside congregations and ministry sites in the city that serve to meet the needs of the people.



Much of our work in Milwaukee is focused on helping our neighbors to fulfill their most basic needs (food, water, clothing, shelter, etc.) in order to reach their full human potential. We are committed to meeting whatever needs local leaders identify.

Of course, we will still have time to enjoy the beautiful lake city of Milwaukee and its unique local gems and attractions.

What does a typical day look like?

A typical day begins with breakfast and devotions before 9:00 a.m., followed by serving with a community organization until around 3:00 p.m. The late afternoon and early evening include scheduled time for showers, free time, dinner, and a variety of evening program/community engagement events. The day concludes with worship, a time for church groups to check-in, and free time before lights out. Sleep comes fast after a full, fun, and meaningful day!

What will it cost? When do I need to sign up?

Total cost of the trip will be approximately \$400-\$500, possibly less - depending on fundraisers, etc. Sign up with your \$100 deposit to reserve your spot at the Nordland church office.

Who is Serve Boldly?

Since 2012, Serve Boldly as an organization has provided teenagers around the country with the opportunity to accompany and serve their neighbor while deepening an understanding of God's presence in their lives.
