World Day of Prayer

Because of COVID our Annual World Day of Prayer event needed to be cancelled for March 5th. However, I want to tell you about the women of the country that wrote the program for this year's theme. You can google the whole story written by the women of the Republic of Vanuatu and get a geographic idea of where Vanuatu is located.

These islands were formed from Volcanic ash about 4000 years ago in the south pacific. Republic consists of 80+ small islands with about 65 inhabited with people of Melanesian descent. Located south east of the Solomon Islands and New Guinea and west of Fuji. The islands were discovered by Europeans in 1606. Population numbers about 275,000. Has tropical climate, most raise their own food and export lots of fish and root vegetables. Papaya's, pineapple, mango's plantains (bananas) and sweet potatoes are abundant most of the year. Coconut milk and coconut cream, flavor many dishes. Very little food is fried. Good education program with 2 Universities. They pay no taxes. Two very large cities and a democratic government. Sport is Soccer. Christianity is the predominant religion, 1/3 are Presbyterian. Country Motto is "With God we stand". They have a parliament and are members of the United Nations. (Sounds like a healthy and great place to live!). No snow but lots of rain, which is the reason for their great rain forests and even not having the best soil, they can produce a great amount of food. Look up this Republic.
