Do your plants need thinning? Do you hate throwing plants out, but can't find a good home for them? Are you looking for new plants or something different for your garden?

The Brantford Master Gardeners is having a "Tailgate Plant Swap" on Sunday, October 4th from 1-4 pm. The location is: Walter's Greenhouses & Garden Centre, 363 Governors Rd E, Paris, ON N3L 3E1

What to bring:

- House plants, succulents / cacti / mature plants, perennials, ROOTED cuttings (even a tiny little root is good, shows that the cutting is indeed growing!), aquatic plants, and bulbs.
 - Clearly label your plant.
 - Put your plant in a container with soil or water; wrap bare roots carefully.
 - The more you bring, the more you'll take home with you.
 - Avoid bringing invasive plants, plants with pests infestation, unhealthy plants or unrooted cuttings.

What to do:

Park your car, then put pots, bags, boxes, whatever container behind your car.

While you wander off to "shop" at other vehicles, others can come by and help themselves to vour plants. If you're lucky, when you come back, all your plants will be gone and you'll have a few new ones for your gardens. The only rule is that you don't take anything out of someone else's car. If you don't have anything to give away, don't worry. Just come out and be willing to give some plants a new home. We don't restrict it to just plants either. It can be seeds, books, pots or anything garden related that you're looking to pass along to someone else.
