## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Reservations:** We do not take reservations for small parties. Its first come first serve. Just walk up. Let us know if you are bringing large group and we will work to accommodate your party. **Fleet Size:** We have 36 solo kayaks, 12 tandem kayaks, and 12 stand up paddle boards. Even on super busy days your wait time is likely minimal.

Payment: We accept all credit cards and cash.

<u>Age Restrictions:</u> Young people must be under adult supervision. Young people may take out their own kayak only if they are strong enough and if conditions are calm. We have life jackets to fit all sizes, including infants.

What to wear/What to bring: Wear swimming attire or clothing than you don't mind getting wet as you are likely to get dripped on. Tipping over is very rare. Bring water, snacks, and sunscreen if you like. We provide all the equipment needed for your trip, including complementary dry bags to keep your stuff dry. Restrooms are available in the marina.

<u>Dogs are welcome</u>: However, we do not have doggie life jackets.

<u>Bringing Your Own Kayak</u>: is only permitted if you someone in your party rents a kayak from us. We do not allow private parties to use our facilities. There is a public launch is on the other side of the marina, but is not suitable at low tide.

**Parking:** is available and free for our guests. Park in our lot by the kayak shack.

<u>A Guide is not Required</u>: You are free to go out on your own. We will show you the basics of how to paddle if you are a new comer. Ask us for route recommendations. We know plenty of great spots for swimming and picnicking.

**Weight Limit:** Tandem kayaks have a 400-pound limit.

**Used Kayaks:** It's not often, but we may have a few kayaks for sale at the end of the season.
