2025 LGA League Schedule

April 9 - Opening Day! Welcome Back Ladies! There will not be a game as most of our LGA ladies might be at the ARFAX ICE Breaker @ Army Navy. We're looking forward to a fabulous season!

April 12 - Red ball game — Each foursome plays with one red ball, with Player 1 using it on the first hole, Player 2 using it on the second hole, and so on. The winner is the foursome that has the lowest combined score while playing the red ball. If the red ball is lost, then that team is disqualified.

April 19 & 26 - Short and Sweet – 9 of the shortest holes on the course will be used for a 9-hole net competition.

April 30 & May 10 - Hard Nine – 9 of the hardest handicapped holes will be used for a 9-hole net competition.

May 14 & 21 - Long and Lovely - The longest 9 holes on the course will be used for a 9-hole net competition.

May 24 & 28 - Throw out par 5's - All par 5 scores will be tossed out for a net score competition.

May 31 & June 4 - Easy Peasy - 9 easiest holes on the course will be used for a 9-hole net competition.

June 11 & 14 - Putt for dough — 0 putts (chip-in) =5 points, 1 putt=4 points, 2 putts=3 points, 3 putt (or more!)=subtract 1 point. Most points after the round will win the 18-hole competition.

June 18 & 25 - Count even holes - All even holes will be used for a 9-hole net competition.

June 28 & July 2 - Bingo — Player will mark her bingo card as she achieves each item listed in the square and when she gets Bingo mark the hole that she made your bingo. Players can only count one square per hole! The player who reaches Bingo in the fewest holes is the winner.

July 5 & 9 - Count 14 - Pro shop will predetermine 4 holes to eliminate from everyone's score for a 14-hole net competition.

July 16 & 23 - Two Lady Team - Ryder cup format. We will select your partner.

- **Holes 1-6: "Better Ball of Pairs"** Each player plays their own ball and the best score of each pair is recorded on the scorecard.
- Holes 7-12: Alternate Shot. Players alternate shots and alternate tees on each of the 6 holes.
- Holes 13-18: Basic scramble format. Each player tees off and the best shot is selected. This continues until the ball is holed.

July 30 & Aug 2 - Stableford – Points will be allocated to net par. The player with the most points will win the 18-hole competition.

• Double Eagle (Albatross): 5 points

Eagle: 4 pointsBirdie: 3 pointsPar: 2 pointsBogey: 1 point

• Double Bogey: 0 points

Aug 6 & 15 - Blind 9 - Pro shop will determine which nine holes will count for 9-hole net competition.

Aug 20 & 23 - Lucky day — After play, throw out one par 3, one par 4 and one par 5 for net 15-hole competition (each hole predetermined by the pro shop).

Aug 27 & 30 - Sweet 16 - Pro shop will discard 1 hole on front nine and 1 hole on back nine for 16-hole net competition.

Sept 3 & 10 - Low Net - Lowest net score wins.

Sept 13 & 17 - Count Odd Holes – All odd holes will be used for a 9-hole net competition.

Sept 24 & 27 - Throw out par 3's - All par 3 scores will be tossed out for a total net score competition.

Oct 1 & 8 - Lucky 4's - Only the par 4's will count.

Oct 11 & 15 - Low Gross - Lowest gross score will win.

Oct 22 - Front 9 - Lowest net score for front 9 will win.

Oct 29 - Joker's Wild - Halloween version of Joker's Wild.

Nov 5 - Back 9 - Lowest net on back 9 will win.
