Local Rules and Conditions of the Competition

Tees: All play will be from the Cozzens (Green) Tees

Format: ABCD Shamble. All players will tee off and the best drive is selected among the group. Once the best drive is selected all players will play from this point. Players will play their own ball until the ball is holed out. For team scores used (two best balls NET each hole) **ALL PUTTS MUST GO IN THE HOLE**. This is a NET event. At least one drive from each player must be used on the front nine and one drive from each on the back nine. Par 3 tee shots count as drives. Each player who purchases the Shotmaker package also gets one magic putt, one mulligan and one sand throw during the round. Please reference your Shotmaker ticket for explanations of how these work.

Closest to the pin on **hole #6 and #13 (HI 1-19.9), hole #4 and #16 (HI over 20).**

Rules: 90* You may take your cart off the path into the fairway at the entry and exit point.

Special Rules Exceptions:

- You may Lift, Clean, and Place your ball in your own fairway one scorecard length, no closer the hole without changing conditions.
- Bunkers will be Rake and Place if you are in a disturbed area.

Pace of Play: Please play without delay. Play "ready golf". This round should be completed in 4 hours and 15 minutes. A Marshal will be present on the course periodically to monitor pace. Ready Golf means that players go to their balls and whoever is ready to hit should hit even if they are not "away" (furthest from the hole). This applies off the tee and in the fairway. Once on the green, each player should mark their ball even if you do not think you are in someone else's line and then be ready when it is your turn.

Additional Local Rules:

- Free relief from all newly sodded areas i.e., the new area on hole #13.
- All Hazards are marked with both Red Stakes and Red Paint. Please play the golf course as it is marked. Out of Bounds is marked by White Stakes.
- Please observe the Green Capped Hazard Stakes down the right side of the fairway on hole #2; around the back-right side of the green on hole #2 and along the first half of the fairway on hole #3.
 - These are environmental hazards, and you cannot enter these areas.
 - This means you must take a one stroke penalty and use of one the drop options per the Rules of Golf. You may not hit from within the environmental hazards.
- Please utilize the white painted Drop Areas on holes #5, #6, and #13. Drop areas are available for pace of play.
 - Using a drop area is not a free drop; it is a one stroke penalty the same as the other options for dropping from a hazard per the Rules of Golf.
- The local Out of Bounds Rule is in play for this event. This rule allows a player to drop on the edge of the fairway closest to where their ball went out of bounds while taking a two-stroke penalty.
