

City Council Proceedings

The Roscoe City Council met in special session in the City Office with Mayor Treichel presiding. Members present were: Hettick, Bauman, Holscher, Hinz and Rohrbach. Absent: Faw. Others present: Jim Fonder and City Attorney Justin Scott.

Mayor Treichel called the meeting to order.

Meeting was called in regards to recent events within Roscoe that were then posted about on Facebook.

The City Council members reviewed the new City Ordinances in regards to pets, with City Attorney Scott giving his legal advice on what possible legal actions could be taken against the City with this event based on our ordinances. He also advised the City that we do have the right given to us in our Ordinances to hold animals found running at large that are not easily identifiable, i.e. not wearing license tags.

Hinz moved and Bauman seconded to approve the first reading of Ordinance #374: An ordinance amending Roscoe City Ordinance 5-3-3. All aye. Motion carried.

Jim Fonder discussed with the Council the new ordinances on weeds and lawn maintenance. He would like for the Council to clarify what ample time should mean in order for a property owner to mow their lawn. This will be looked at further for the June Council meeting.

Hettick moved and Bauman seconded to adjourn. Motion carried.
