How to schedule

Vaccinations are being provided by appointment only. Appointments can be made by visiting vaccinate.christushealth.org and following the 4 easy steps below. If you need assistance scheduling or have vaccine questions, you may also call the following dedicated phone line: (877) 335-5746.

1 CLICK ON THE YELLOW CHAT BUBBLE ON THE RIGHT-HAND SIDE OF THE PAGE

You'll be introduced to Christy our virtual assistant, who will help you through the process. If you do not see the yellow icon to your right, appointments are full.

2 DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY

You will be prompted to answer a few screening questions, which help us make sure you are eligible to receive a vaccine prior to scheduling an appointment.

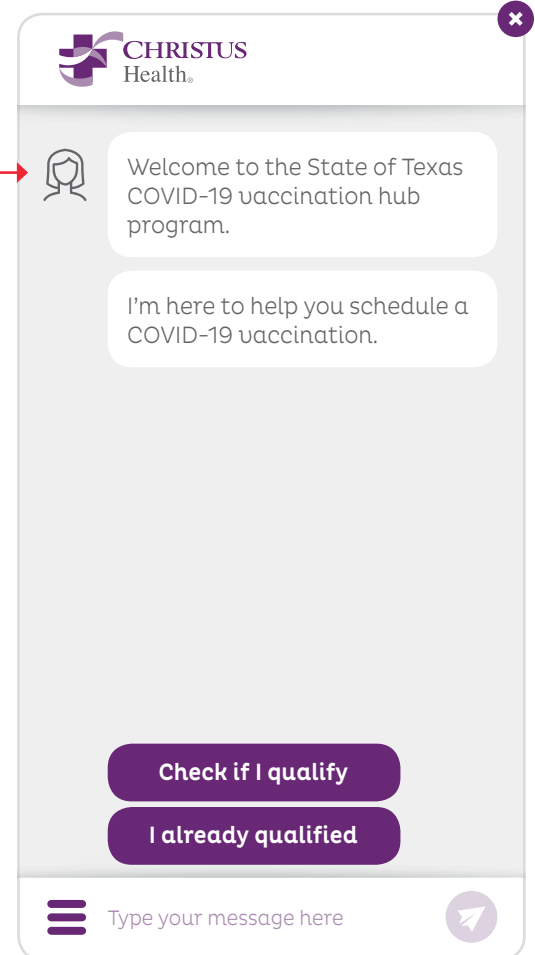
We are currently providing these FREE vaccines to people who meet the criteria for the State's **Phase 1A** (health care workers and long-term care residents) and **Phase 1B** (65 and older or 16 years of age and older with chronic conditions).

3 SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT

If you qualify for the vaccine, Christy will find available appointment options. More appointments will be opened as more vaccine is shipped from the state.

4 COMPLETE REGISTRATION

Fill out all patient information and confirm your appointment date, time and location.

Important information for appointment day

- Each person needs their own individual appointment for vaccination. **Walk-ins and waitlist appointments are not available.**
- The event will be held at the **Longview Exhibit Center at the Longview Convention Complex** (100 Grand Blvd. | Longview | TX 75604).
- Please arrive no more than 15 minutes before your appointment. You will be asked to remain in your vehicle until 5 minutes before your appointment time.
- Only those being vaccinated may attend the clinic, except for those who need assistance. Those who cannot come alone to their appointment may bring 1 essential visitor.
- Wear loose fitting clothes, for ease in accessing your shoulder to administer the vaccine.
- Masks are required. Please bring your own mask.
