### Baigali and Dancers

Baigali and Dancers is committed to preserving and sharing the rich traditions of Mongolian and other East Asian ethnic dance forms. As an independent, woman-owned studio, Baigali and Dancers provides a welcoming space for dancers of all levels to explore cultural dance while developing strength, flexibility, and confidence.

For Baigali and Dancers, dance is more than movement—it is a journey of self-discovery, connection, and healing for both body and soul. The studio is dedicated to providing a supportive and inspiring environment for the dancers to experience the joy of dance.

Baigali, a member of the Urad tribe from Inner Mongolia, China, holds a Bachelor of Arts from Minzu University (China College of Dance) and two Master's degrees. She first earned her Master of Fine Arts in Choreography and Dance Directing from the Mongolian University of Art and Culture in Mongolia. After relocating to the United States, she pursued and obtained her second Master's degree in Dance Education from New York University. Throughout her academic journey, Baigali garnered numerous awards in prestigious dance competitions, including the Lotus Cup and Taoli Cup. She also gained extensive experience as a choreographer and dance teacher, working for many years at the Primary School Affiliated to Capital Normal University and the Beijing Institute of Fashion Technology. As a seasoned educator, she has dedicated years to preparing students for dance school entrance exams and guiding them toward admission into top-tier dance colleges. In addition to her teaching accomplishments, Baigali served as the Chief Director and choreographer for the 2019 Inner Mongolia Spring Festival Gala. That same year, she was also invited to judge a fashion model competition in Hohhot, China. In 2021, Baigali and her partner co-founded their dance studio, Baigali and Dancers. Through her passion for dance and her consistent, disciplined training methods, Baigali aspires to inspire and nurture the inner dancer in everyone.

MANACAN is a South African Company based in London consisting of two artists, Ciara Baldwin and Nathan Bartman, who choreograph, compose, perform and tour their own productions. MANA in the language KhoeKhoegowab means 'them that give' and CAN stands for 'Ciara and Nathan'.

They explore primal topics and express them through dance, physicality, vocals and music – their style is earthy and influenced by their South African roots. They work with dance and musical styles ranging from African and hip-hop to contemporary, while continually learning from different styles, places and people, taking them to unique and often vulnerable places both physically and spiritually.





#### Natasha Carlitz Dance Ensemble

Founded in 2005, the Natasha Carlitz Dance Ensemble performs powerful modern dance choreography addressing themes ranging from abstract mathematical concepts and verbal games to the physical puzzles posed by unusual spaces.
