He has training in ballet, modern, contemporary, lyrical, hip hop, jazz, and tap. Aside from the more classic styles, he has also been trained in styles with cultural influences including Ballet Folklorico, Cumbia, Bachata, African, and Capoeira. In the US, she has rendered solo recitals across NYC, WA, NJ, Boston, CA, Chicago. She has also worked with other dance companies on select projects (Navatman in NY, Noorani, Naatak, Pampa in bay area, Alapadma, Arpan in Seattle). Pooja was an AIR for the prestigious Seattle Theater Group(2024) where she presented at the Moore Theater. She also recently premiered her work as a part of the Seattle Office of Arts&Culture. She premiered her other work as a part of YUVA(2023), Houston and at Yuva Bharati, California (Nov 2023). She was one of the 8 chosen artists across the US for a production that got featured on Narthaki. She has also has the opportunity to present her work at the New York Kathak Festival (2024). She recently toured with ADC across 11 cities in the US and Canada. Pooja has been an invited artist for workshops and demos in Kathak across the US.

## **Stacey Fong**

Stacey is a dance instructor specializing in Bachata, having taught and performed at International Bachata Festivals. For the fourth year running, Stacey is director of the Bay Area chapter of the World Bachata Teams EMENVI by Magda & Valeria, and is choreographer/director of her own Femme Bachata team, the Sirenitas. In addition to Bachata, Stacey is also skilled at social dances, ballroom, pole, and chair. She teaches group classes and private lessons at Dance Boulevard (San Jose) and Twirly Studios (Pleasanton). When she is not on the dance floor, Stacey is a voiceover actress whose voice can be heard in videogames, IVR systems, and Cirque du Soleil.



#### Natasha Carlitz Dance Ensemble

Founded in 2005, the Natasha Carlitz Dance Ensemble presented its inaugural concert in partnership with the internationally acclaimed California Guitar Trio and since then has produced twelve more full-length programs as well as appearing in dozens of showcases and festivals around the Bay Area. Athletic and spirited, NCDE dancers bring both strong technique and emotional depth to their performances.

With its strong focus on musicality, the company has commissioned work from a number of composers and seizes opportunities to perform with live musicians, including two invitations from folk-rock duo Emma's Revolution. "Serious and graceful work... displays creativity and talent that are worth seeing... One of the really successful features of Carlitz' work is that the selected music and choreography fit so well together," writes Michael Phelan of baydance.com.
