Job Description:

This position is responsible for providing and maintaining a quality experience for all volunteers in cooperation with the operations and development teams of Mercer County Food Bank. Primary responsibilities include use of warehouse equipment to set up for each volunteer shift, providing clear communication and guidance to volunteers prior to the start of each shift, moving pallets, boxes, food, etc. during the shift, working alongside volunteers as needed, and use of warehouse equipment to clean up after each shift and prep for the next project.

Essential Duties:

- Follow food safety and food donor guidelines in product handling.
- Set-up packing rooms for each volunteer shift – includes tables, rollers, boxes, supplies, pallets of food, etc.
- Provide clear communication/instruction to the volunteers prior to the start of the shift.
- Move pallets and supplies as needed during the shift.
- Work alongside volunteers when needed.
- Tear-down and clean the packing room at the end of each shift.
- Prepare packing rooms for next project/volunteer shift.
- Assist Operations team in cleaning throughout warehouse as needed.
