

2020 Fran Sargent Scholarship Criteria

Eligibility: Open to any woman with at least a Private Pilot certificate who is a resident of Florida or currently enrolled in an aviation training program in Florida.

Amount: Maximum of \$3,000.00 to be used for an FAA certificate or rating.

Selection Criteria: The recipient of the scholarship will be selected by a committee consisting of judges active in aviation. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final. If no qualified applicant applies, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withhold the scholarship.

Applications are judged with priority given in no particular order: Ability to be an ambassador representing women in aviation and participation in the Ninety-Nines or aviation events and activities, demonstration of financial need, desire to obtain a career in aviation and/or, likelihood of success at reaching your goals, neatness, attention to detail and completeness of the application package.
