The State Level Committee constituted as per provisions of rule 10 of West Bengal Right of Children to free & Compulsory Education Rules, 2012 in its meeting dated 04/09/2019 had approved the proposal of issuance of "No Objection Certificate"/ Certificate of Recognition and hence The School Education Directorate hereby issues "Permanent No Objection Certificate"/Certificate of Recognition for Class 1(One) to Class VIII(Eight) in respect of Banimandir Rural Public School, as an unaided school, for the purpose of preparing its candidate to appear in the final examination of the Central Board of Secondary education and subject to observance of the following terms and conditions all the time falling which the "Permanent No Objection Certificate:/ Certificate of Recognition issued in favour of the school may be withdrawn.

1. The School authority shall maintain and fulfill all the conditions all the time as mention in the Rule10 (15) of the WB RTE Rules, 2012.
2. That the school authority shall never claim any financial assistance from the State govt.
3. That the school shall be located in a relatively noise free and population free area having adequate supply of drinking water and electricity.
4. That the school shall have classroom of adequate apace commensurate with the enrollment which is comfortable and suitable for imparting lesson and not less than the number of class units.
5. That the school have a playground for the students and a barrier free access.
6. (a) That the school shall have separate toilet for the boys and girls in case of co-ed school and teachers.
6. (b) That the school shall have girls common room if it is a girls or co-ed school, teachers room and adequate furniture.
7. That the school shall have sufficient fire safety equipments and have trained persons among the staff to operate equipments.
