Amy “Catfox” Champion is a dance artist and the founder and artistic director of Antics. Her vision is to unify diverse audiences through the transformational experience of hip-hop dance theater performances. Champion’s work crosses artistic and cultural boundaries: transplanting hip-hop dance from street to stage and telling stories through a multimedia intersection of dance, theater, film, poetry, graffiti art, and music. Through a collaborative creative process, Champion crafts street dance movements into moving visual metaphors that showcase the virtuosity and expressive capacity of hip-hop art forms. Champion has 20 years of experience as a BGirl and Capoeirista and has performed and taught nationally and internationally. In addition to Antics, she has performed with Rennie Harris PureMovement, Jacob “Kujo” Lyons’ Lux Aeterna Dance Company, and CONTRA-TIEMPO. Champion’s work extends to the commercial entertainment realm where she has choreographed for and appeared in music videos, films, corporate events, and television shows. Champion was short-listed for a Kevin Spacey artist award in 2015 and has also received awards from LA County Arts Commission and holds an MFA in Choreography from UCLA.
