## Specimens

- A vase must be greater in height than in width.
- Three cuts means three containers - one for each cut.
- Containers are supplied.
- NND = Not Necessarily Distinct.
- Pelargonium should be staged with a leaf behind the flower.
- Zonal have a soft leaf with a darker horseshoe shaped band in the centre.
- Regal have a hard leaf with serrated edges.
- Ivy leaf have harder shiny leaf with rounded edge.

- Foliage Designs. minimal accessories such as sticks and stones may be used.
- Maximum space allowed: 75 cm wide and 60 cm deep. For an exhibit to be correctly placed, it should not take up more than two thirds (2/3) of this space for an advantageous judging position.
- There are no other restrictions unless specifically stated.

- Hanging containers must not exceed 35 cm diameter.
- Multiple plantings must be distinct so that the judge may assess the number of plants present in the container.
