1. VIOLATION OF THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION AND FORFEITURE OF ALL RIGHTS, PRIZES, OR WINNINGS, IN ANY CATEGORY, BY THE PERSON DISQUALIFIED. **THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL.**
2. JACKPOTS - BOATS ENTERING ANY JACKPOT MUST HAVE ONE JACKPOT TICKET PER BOAT, PLUS EACH PERSON ON BOARD MUST HAVE A RODEO TICKET - SEE JACKPOT RULES.
3. ALL FISH ENTERED INTO COMPETITION MUST BE CAUGHT BY THE PARTICIPANT REGISTERING THE FISH, AND IT MUST BE CAUGHT WITH A MANUAL ROD AND REEL, OR POLE AND LINE.
4. THE CATCH SHALL NOT BE FROZEN, GIGGED, NETTED, SNAGGED, OR SHOT, AND MUST BE WHOLE. THE ONLY HOLES ALLOWED ARE HOOK AND GAFF.
5. EACH PERSON ON BOARD MUST HAVE A RODEO TICKET, OR JUNIOR ANGLER TICKET (IF UNDER 15), WHETHER THEY FISH OR NOT. **FAILURE TO MAKE SURE ALL OCCUPENTS HAVE THE REQUIRED TICKET WILL RESULT IN ALL CATCHES ON THAT VESSEL BEING DISQUALIFIED.**
6. NO PERSON SHALL INCREASE THE WEIGHT OF THE FISH BY "STUFFING". (THE FISH WILL BE CUT.)
7. ALL CATCHES MUST BE WEIGHED IN AT DAUPHIN ISLAND MARINA DURING THE ABOVE HOURS AS SET. IN THE EVENT OF A LINE HAVING FORMED PRIOR TO THE OFFICIAL ENDING TIME AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE RODEO, ALL ANGLERS WHO ARE **IN LINE** WHEN TIME IS CALLED WILL BE WEIGHED. **IN LINE IS DEFINED AS BEING PHYSICALLY IN LINE** (NOT "ON THE DOCK"), **WITH ALL FISH TO BE WEIGHED IN.** THE END OF THIS LINE WILL BE MARKED WITH A RODEO STAFF MEMBER. **HAVING FISH BROUGHT TO YOU WHILE IN LINE, AFTER THE CLOSING, WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.** LATE ARRIVALS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.
8. ALL FISHING WILL BE DONE IN A SPORTSMAN-LIKE MANNER AS LADIES AND GENTLEMEN.
9. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES WILL BE FINAL IN ALL RESPECTS. INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, WEIGHT, SPECIES, AND METHOD OF CATCH.
10. IN CASE OF A TIE, WINNER WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE FIRST WEIGHT RECORDED AT THE SCALES.
11. ALL FISH ENTERED IN THE RODEO MUST BE CAUGHT IN THE SPECIFIED TIME PERIOD.
12. IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS, NO UNDERSIZE FISH WILL BE ALLOWED. IN THE REDFISH AND SPECKLED TROUT CATEGORIES, ALL ENTRIES MUST MEASURE WITHIN THE RESPECTIVE "SLOT". (Redfish slot is 16 inch minimum – 26 inch maximum : Speckled Trout slot is 15 inch minimum – 22 inch maximum) NO OVER SIZE FISH WILL BE ALLOWED. ALL LENGTHS WILL BE MEASURED WITH TAILS IN THE "NATURAL" POSITION (NOT PINCHED), UNLESS REGULATIONS REQUIRE OTHERWISE. TAILS DETERMINED TO HAVE BEEN CUT MAY DISQUALIFY THE ANGLER.
13. C.C.M.G.F.R. RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHANGE ANY FISH SPECIES FOR COMPETITION SHOULD CONSERVATION LAWS PROHIBIT THE HARVEST OF ORIGINALLY DESIGNATED SPECIES FOR COMPETITION.
14. ONE EIGHT (8) HOUR PERIOD WITHOUT A SMALL CRAFT ADVISORY ISSUED BY THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN MOBILE SHALL CONSTITUTE A RODEO. IN THE ABSENCE OF SUCH, JUDGE AND COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO RESCHEDULE.
15. PROTEST OF ANY NATURE MUST BE IN WRITING AND PERSONALLY TURNED IN TO THE RODEO CHAIRMAN NO LATER THAN 5:00 P.M SUNDAY, AUGUST 11th, 2024 AT THE WEIGH-IN STATION.
16. ALL PRIZES **NOT** CLAIMED BY SEPTEMBER 30, 2024 MAY BECOME PROPERTY OF THE CONDE CAVALIERS MARDI GRAS FISHING RODEO.

Entry Fee - \$20 per person

1. Junior Angler Tournament open to all Junior Anglers age 15 & under as of August 10th, 2024
2. All participants in the Junior Angler Tournament must purchase a separate Junior Angler ticket.
3. Participants in the Junior Angler tournament desiring to enter fish in the overall rodeo must also have an Open Rodeo Ticket.
4. Participants in the Junior Angler Tournament will only be allowed to place one fish, per angler, per category, per day. Participants are welcome to weigh in as many fish, in each category, as conservation laws will allow. However, only the single fish with the greatest weight, per category, will make the leader board.
5. In the event of a tie, the first fish weighed in will be determined the winner.
6. All entrants' fish must be caught on hook and line.
7. Categories for Junior Angler Tournament are as follows:
 - Croaker
 - Flounder
 - Gafftopsail Catfish
 - Ground Mullet
 - Hardhead Catfish
 - Pinfish
 - Redfish
 - Sheepshead
 - Speckled Trout
 - White Trout
8. Overall Junior Angler will be determined on a points system similar to that of Master Angler, and other Top Angler Awards. (3 points will be awarded for 1st place, 2 for 2nd, and 1 for 3rd)
9. In the event of a tie in the total points awarded for Overall Junior Angler, the winner will be determined by the angler with the highest cumulative total weight of fish, for which points have been awarded.
10. Official Weigh Station is at Dauphin Island Marina. Weigh-in Times are the same as the C.C.M.G.F.R.
11. Unless specifically superseded, varied, or exempted by these Junior Anglers Tournament rules, all rules for the Conde Cavalier Mardi Gras Fishing Rodeo also apply.

TOP MALE ANGLER, TOP LADY ANGLER & TOP JUNIOR ANGLER AWARDS

1. ALL ANGLERS, HOLDING A 2024 MARDI GRAS FISHING RODEO TICKET, ARE ELIGIBLE TO QUALIFY FOR THE MASTER ANGLER, TOP MALE, AND TOP LADY ANGLER AWARDS.
2. ALL ANGLERS AGE 15 & UNDER, HOLDING A 2024 MARDI GRAS FISHING RODEO JUNIOR ANGLER TICKET, ARE ELIGIBLE TO QUALIFY FOR THE TOP JUNIOR ANGLER AWARD.
3. POINTS WILL BE AWARDED IN EACH CATEGORY ACCORDING TO RANKING ON THE OFFICIAL JUDGE'S SCORE SHEETS. (ALL DECISIONS ARE FINAL.)
4. FOUR POINTS WILL BE AWARDED FOR FIRST PLACE, THREE FOR SECOND PLACE, AND TWO FOR THIRD PLACE IN EACH CATEGORY. **(THREE FOR FIRST, TWO FOR SECOND, ONE FOR THIRD IN THE CASE OF JUNIOR ANGLERS)**
5. NO ANGLER WILL BE AWARDED POINTS, (OR JUNIOR ANGLER POINTS), FOR MULTIPLE FISH IN THE SAME CATEGORY, EVEN THOUGH THEY MAY HAVE MORE THAN ONE FISH ON THE BOARD IN ANY CATEGORY.
6. IN THE CASE OF MORE THAN ONE FISH IN A CATEGORY, POINTS WILL BE AWARDED ACCORDING TO THE HIGHEST PLACED FISH.
7. IN THE CASE OF A TIE IN THE TOTAL POINTS AWARDED, WINNER WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE ANGLER WITH THE HIGHEST CUMULATIVE TOTAL WEIGHT OF FISH FOR WHICH POINTS HAVE BEEN AWARDED.
8. THE TITLE OF MASTER ANGLER SHALL BE AWARDED TO THE INDIVIDUAL ANGLER (MALE OR FEMALE), WITH THE HIGHEST RANKING AFTER ALL POINTS HAVE BEEN AWARDED, AND, ANY TIE BREAKERS (see Rule 7 above) HAVE BEEN FACTORED IN.
9. THE TITLE OF TOP MALE ANGLER, AND TOP LADY ANGLER, SHALL BE AWARDED TO THE INDIVIDUAL MALE, OR FEMALE, ANGLERS POSSESSING THE NEXT HIGHEST RANKINGS AFTER THE INDIVIDUAL BEING AWARDED THE TITLE OF MASTER ANGLER HAS BEEN DETERMINED.
10. Because our rules allow anglers participating in the Junior Anglers Tournament to also participate in the Rodeo, if purchasing a separate ticket, the following rule shall apply - IN THE EVENT THAT THE MASTER ANGLER, TOP MALE ANGLER, OR TOP LADY ANGLER SHOULD TURN OUT TO ALSO BE THE ANGLER WITH THE HIGHEST JUNIOR ANGLER POINTS AWARDED, THEN THE TITLE OF TOP JUNIOR ANGLER WILL GO TO THE ANGLER WITH THE NEXT HIGHEST POINTS TOTAL FOR THAT AWARD.
11. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL.
