During a brief adoption Adara got a taste of life in a home. She seemed to be potty trained and indicated when she needed to go outside, and she was working on crate training. Adara will need a patient family who can help her feel safe when left home alone.

Adara shares her kennel with another PACC pup and has been social and easygoing when meeting other dogs on playgroup.
