



- Teaches IELTS and supports students with other subjects



A safe, friendly and supportive living environment is arranged for all international students, either with a homestay family or boarding at Lupton House.

Lupton House provides safe and secure boarding within the school grounds, with friendly, caring staff and a safe and welcoming atmosphere. Lupton House is within walking distance to doctors, shopping and sporting facilities. Homestay accommodation is arranged by our international team, with all host families offering a safe, friendly home that is carefully chosen to suit our visiting students.

All homestay and boarding students are well supported, with routines and guidelines to enhance opportunities for educational and social learning and development.

Our school clubs also offer a wide range of learning and development opportunities in leadership, health, the environment and global issues, as well as providing friendship and fun.


