CURRICULUM

Our unique high school preparation programme is fully accredited by New Zealand Qualification Authority (NZQA) and students are able to gain portable credits in National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) levels 1 and 1 in selected subjects. Specialist maths and science classes introduce students to the technical vocabulary of those subjects and help ease the transition into the New Zealand education system.

Short-term students also enjoy our English plus Activities programmes that run on a seasonal basis.

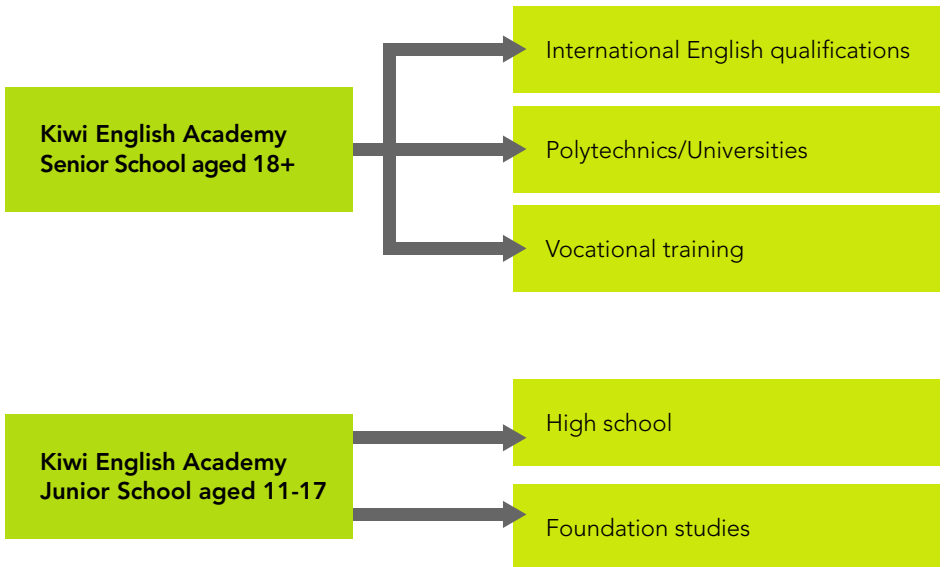

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APPLICATION PROCEDURE

STEP ONE

The student completes the Kiwi English Academy enrolment form and the KiwiCare accommodation request form. Students going to high school or a tertiary institute should also send:

- a) a copy of passport/birth certificate
- b) copies of academic transcripts

STEP TWO

Kiwi English Academy reviews the application and sends an offer of place, the enrolment contract and an invoice.

STEP THREE

After carefully reviewing all the information, the student and/or his/her parents sign and return the enrolment contract to Kiwi English Academy and pay the fees.

STEP FOUR

Kiwi English Academy sends a confirmed offer of place and receipt. Accommodation and guardianship is organised.

STEP FIVE

The student applies for a student visa and informs Kiwi English Academy of flight arrival details (at least 2 weeks prior to arrival).

STEP SIX

Kiwi English Academy organises airport pick-up and transfer to accommodation.

CODE OF PRACTICE
