This consists of 23 hours normal class time plus 3 hours or more of optional study, including pronunciation class, conversation class, Job Hunter, Coffee Club, and teacher-guided self-study in our Self Access Learning Centre 'The Learning Hub'. Optional classes are available to full-time and part-time students.</li></ul>
