Learning Together, Growing Stronger

In the past six weeks, I've been training with Fire and Fragrance YWAM (Youth With A Mission). Every Monday, we go out to local colleges to evangelize, pray for people, make connections, and invite them to something we call "Monday Nights", a time of worship and a short message.

On Thursdays, we split into three teams: one serves food to the homeless, another visits an after-school program to connect with teens and share the good news of Jesus, and my team spends time playing games with and tutoring refugee kids in subjects like math, English, and more.

For our upcoming trip to the Philippines, we'll be involved in prison ministry, red light district outreach, and community connection.

A major struggle in the Philippines is identity, including those in LGBTQ+ community. Many here wrestle with self-worth, searching for a design that was not given to them by God. Others try to lighten their skin or hair to look more "white."

Our heart is to remind them that they are fearfully and wonderfully made, and to help them find their true identity in Jesus.

We'll also visit floating villages and an island that is home to a fully Muslim community, where we hope to share about "the Man in White", the figure many Muslims see in their dreams, and reveal to them who He truly is. Please PRAY for spiritual and physical protection and divine opportunities. I'm so excited to leave at the beginning of January and can't wait to share how God works.
