

A Lamp to My Feet A Light to My Path

The word of God says "Your word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light to my path". (Psalm 119:105) Sometimes Jesus, who is the word (John 1:14) is a lamp unto our feet. This means that we might not be able to see far in front of us and we just follow where the Lord leads us, step by step. Sometimes, Jesus is a light unto our path and He lights up further in front of us to see where we are going or perhaps help us to choose the right path to follow. Both can be important at different times and in different seasons. I encourage you to sit in His presence and ask to feel His love for you. Receive His love and His healing. He is a tree of life. He is the vine and you are the branches (John 15:5). If you don't feel that you have Kingdom family around you, I pray that you would be brought into family in Jesus name. Something that you might like to think about and discuss is how can you bring God's design for Kingdom family here on earth? Creative Cooking





A friend shared the idea for this dip recently with us. We made a few changes, worked out the ratios for the recipe and love it! It's super simple but very yummy. We made it nut free with sunflower seeds and hemp seeds but you can use cashews instead if you want to. It's delicious with veggie sticks, crackers or even on pita bread or toast with some other toppings too.

INGREDIENTS

¼ - ½ of Kent Pumpkin (approx 1.5-2kg before cutting) 1 onion

1/2 cup sunflower seeds (chopped)

1/2 cup hemp seeds

1-2 teaspoons garlic power (to taste)

1-2 teaspoons crushed garlic from fridge (to taste)

1/2 teaspoon salt

A little olive oil and salt (to cook pumpkin)



METHOD

Step 1:

Chop the pumpkin and onion into small chunks and put them on an oven tray. Drizzle a little olive oil on top, sprinkle some salt and cook in an oven for 30-40mins at 180°C.

Step 2:

Chop up the sunflower seeds or pulse them in a blender so there are still some larger pieces left.

Step 3:

Once the pumpkin and onion are cooled, put them in a blender with the garlic powder, crushed garlic and salt. Blitz them together until fairly smooth.

Step 4:

Empty the pumpkin and onion mix into a bowl and mix through the chopped sunflower seeds and hemp seeds.

Step 5:

Enjoy with some carrot, cucumber and celery sticks, crackers or in a wrap! Store in the fridge.








Ways you can show love

Hello Kingdom Family! You are children of God! You are saved by grace, through your faith (see Ephesians 2:8-9)! Now that we have been saved, our love for Jesus means we care about what He cares about! I believe that God cares about:

- what we believe (see Romans 10:9-10)
- how we love (see I John 4:10-11)
- and what we do (see Ephesians 2:10)

When Jesus comes again, He will not judge us according to what church we went to or how often. He wants you to know and believe the truth. He wants you to know His love and show others that love. And, He wants you to be a blessing to this world out of your love for Him! So, let's learn a little more about these things!



Faith is like a tree: believing is the roots, love is the leaves, acting is the fruit

Let's think about our faith like a tree: believing is like the roots, love is like the leaves and acting is like the fruit. Our faith tree goes through a journey, starting as just a small seed that we allow to be planted...


Do you know the first thing that a seed does in its life? It puts down roots. This is like our faith; when we believe in Jesus and are saved, we put out roots so that we have a good foundation to build our faith on. Jesus was sent by the Father to bring people into the kingdom (see John 6:38-40). He calls us to believe in Him (see John 11:25-26). As a child of God himself, Jesus came to tell people how amazing it is and to bring lost children home. Jesus wants to show us what is true (see John 8:32). The Bible even says that Jesus is the truth (see John 14:6).

After a seed puts out roots, it sends leaves up so it can get light and energy. Once we decide to believe in Jesus, we can see how much God loves us and we have the opportunity to show that love to others. Our Heavenly Father loves us so much (see John 3:16)! We don't need to do things to earn God's love, but we receive God's love and we release that love to others. He is better than the best dad you could ever imagine. Our Heavenly Father loves us and He created us; when we know this truth we are transformed! Always remember, even when you don't feel like it or you've been told otherwise, you are so loved, you are not alone and you are a beloved kid of the King of kings (see John 1:12)!

Let's imagine, our seed has grown into a tall tree, it has roots and leaves, but it hasn't produced fruit yet. God sent us the Holy Spirit, our Helper, to help teach us how to act (see John 14:26). Acting the way God asks us to it like fruit on our tree, it is delicious to God. Remember though, that we are not doing things to earn God's love. The way we act doesn't make God love us more or less, but when we do what He asks us to, He trusts us with greater tasks to build His Kingdom (see Matthew 25:23)!

Activation

Our faith is like a tree: believing is the roots, love is the leaves and acting is the fruit. Now we have learnt more about loving, believing and acting, how are we empowered to do this in our life? Below I have some ideas to get you started and then you can write some of your own ideas down. Think of different ways in your life that you can grow your belief, share God's love and act upon your beliefs. Then, find time to start doing these things.




Jesus and the Woman at the Well

News was spreading throughout Aenon that Jesus was baptizing more people than even John the Baptist! Jesus decided to leave to go to Galilee, but on his way he stopped by Jacob's well in Samaria. Jesus sat down to rest there.

Now, Jews and Samaritans did NOT associate with each other. They did not talk to each other, eat with each other, or share their drinking vessels with one another. They had different beliefs about where they should worship God. The Jews believed that God dwelt in the temple in Jerusalem, and the Samaritans believed God dwelt on Mount Gerizim. Jesus was a Jew and he was in Samaria, the thought of it was crazy!



As Jesus sat by the well, a Samaritan woman came to collect water. Jesus started talking to her; she was very surprised to hear a Jew talk to her because, as you know, Jews didn't mix with Samaritans! Then, Jesus asked the woman for a drink which was even more shocking because, as you know, Jews and Samaritans would not drink from the same vessel! But Jesus kept talking, "If you only knew who I am and the gift that God wants to give you - you'd ask me for a drink, and I would give to you living water." (John 4:10 TPT)

This surprised the Samaritan woman even more because it was a very deep well and Jesus had nothing to collect water with. So, the woman asked Jesus, "Where then do You get that living water? Jesus said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life." That sounded amazing; no wonder the Samaritan woman jumped at the chance to get this water! She asked Jesus, "Let me drink that water so I'll never be thirsty again and won't have to come back here to draw water." (John 4:15 TPT)



Jesus asked the woman many questions about her life. But the amazing thing is that not only did Jesus ask the questions, but he told her the answers; answers no one else could have known. He told her about sins she had done. The woman was amazed! She thought that He must have been a prophet.

Then she asked Jesus why he thought that God dwelt in the temple, not on the mountain (a most controversial topic)? Jesus told her that the Messiah is coming, and that it will no longer matter where we worship God; but because God is Spirit, we will worship him in Spirit and truth. The Samaritan woman replied that she knew the Messiah was coming. Jesus spoke saying, "I am He."

The Samaritan woman believed and returned to her village to tell the great news that the promised Messiah had come! She spoke to them saying, "Come, see a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?". (John 4:29) Many believed because of her testimony; others came to talk to Jesus themselves and they believed because of what they heard!

Wow! Isn't this story amazing! Jesus came to save not only the Jews, but everyone, both sinners and saints. The Samaritan woman found the Messiah, Jesus! He gave her the living water she needed.

We all have a well inside of us and a thirst to know our creator and His love. Just like the Samaritan woman, people try doing lots of different things to quench this thirst. If we are trying to fill our spirit with anything other than Jesus, it will not last and it will run out. If we try to fill our well up again and again with anything other than Jesus, we will only become empty again and again.



Jesus is living water; he quenches our thirst! Everything we need is found in him. When we are full of Jesus, we act like him, loving people, teaching the truth and showing the lost who Jesus is! If you haven't accepted Jesus into your life please read more on pages 25 and 26.

Jesus showed the Samaritan woman grace. Jesus came for the lost, broken and misunderstood, those that are lost and thought of as different. The Samaritan woman was one of these. When she met Jesus, she was transformed; then she went back to her village to share the good news and tell people her testimony (what Jesus did in her life). Her testimony helped many people believe that Jesus was the Messiah. So even though we may think that we are not able to be used by God, He may have other plans. Even though we may think we are broken, God can still use us while He heals us!


Has God done something in your life? It can be big or small. I know he has done amazing things for me; he saved me, healed me and has continued to transform me. That is my testimony. God gives us a testimony to share with others so they may believe too. God can use anything for good. If you are broken or your well feels empty, God can turn it around and give you an amazing testimony!

In John 4:14, Jesus was speaking to the woman at the well and said, "Whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life." She responded that she would very much like this water! If I had to walk to get my water every day at a well, I think I would too!

So, what is this water and how do we get it? Well, the Bible verse above says that Jesus Himself provides this water. He also says that "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." John 7:38

So Jesus is the living water! When you invite Him into your heart to live, He provides this living water for you! He is like an invigorating waterfall washing over you with His love and life. He is like a refreshing cold drink on a hot and thirsty day. He is clean and pure water to wash yourself clean in. Wow, how amazing is this? I know I certainly want all of these things!



Indescribable -100 Devotions about Cod & Science




Indescribable is a devotion book that contains 100 devotions about God and Science, written by Louie Giglio.
