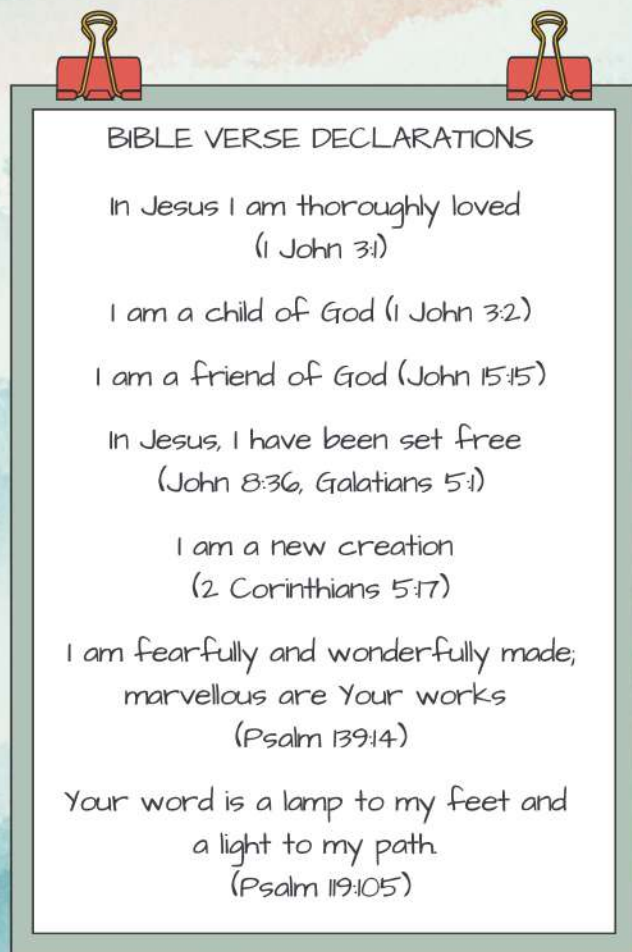

## WHO JESUS IS

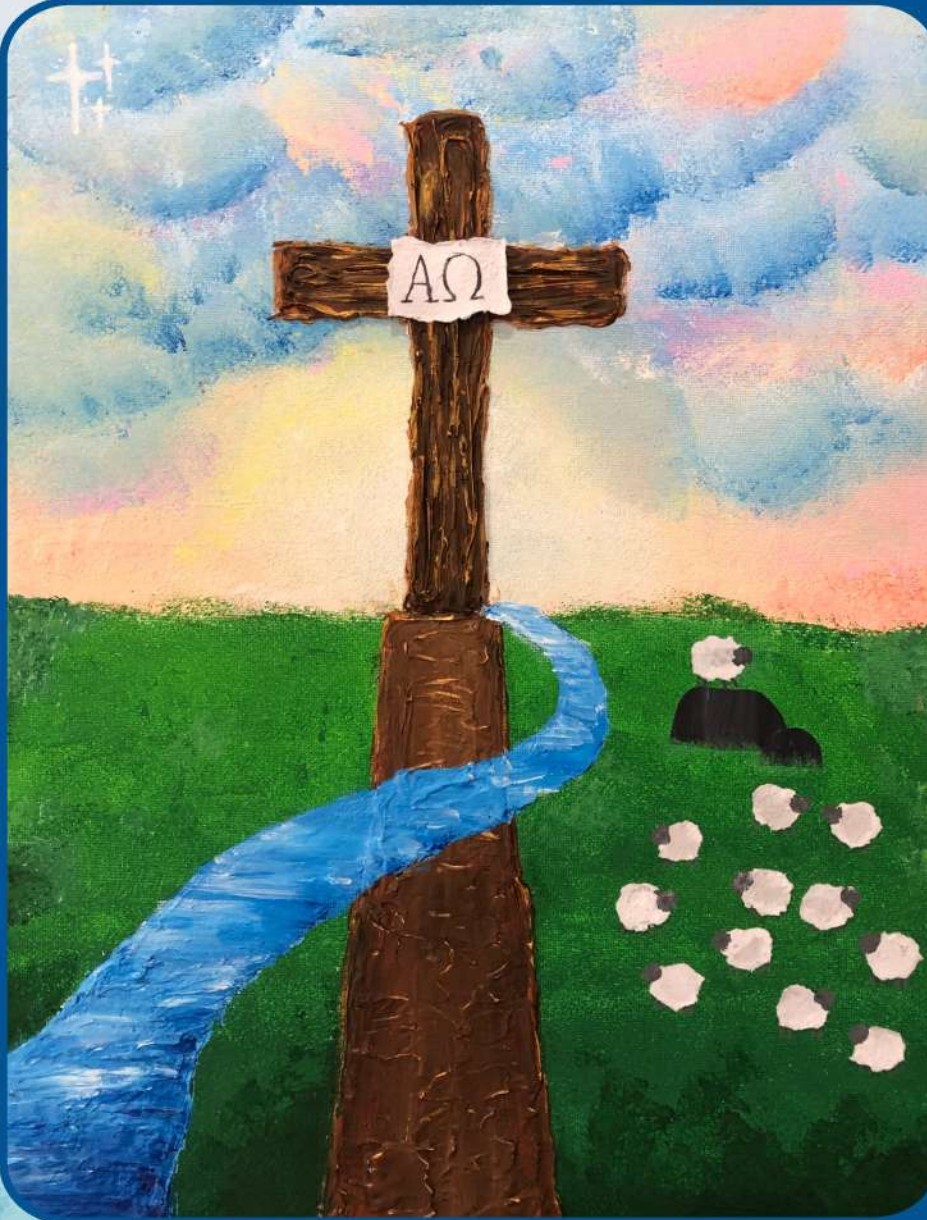

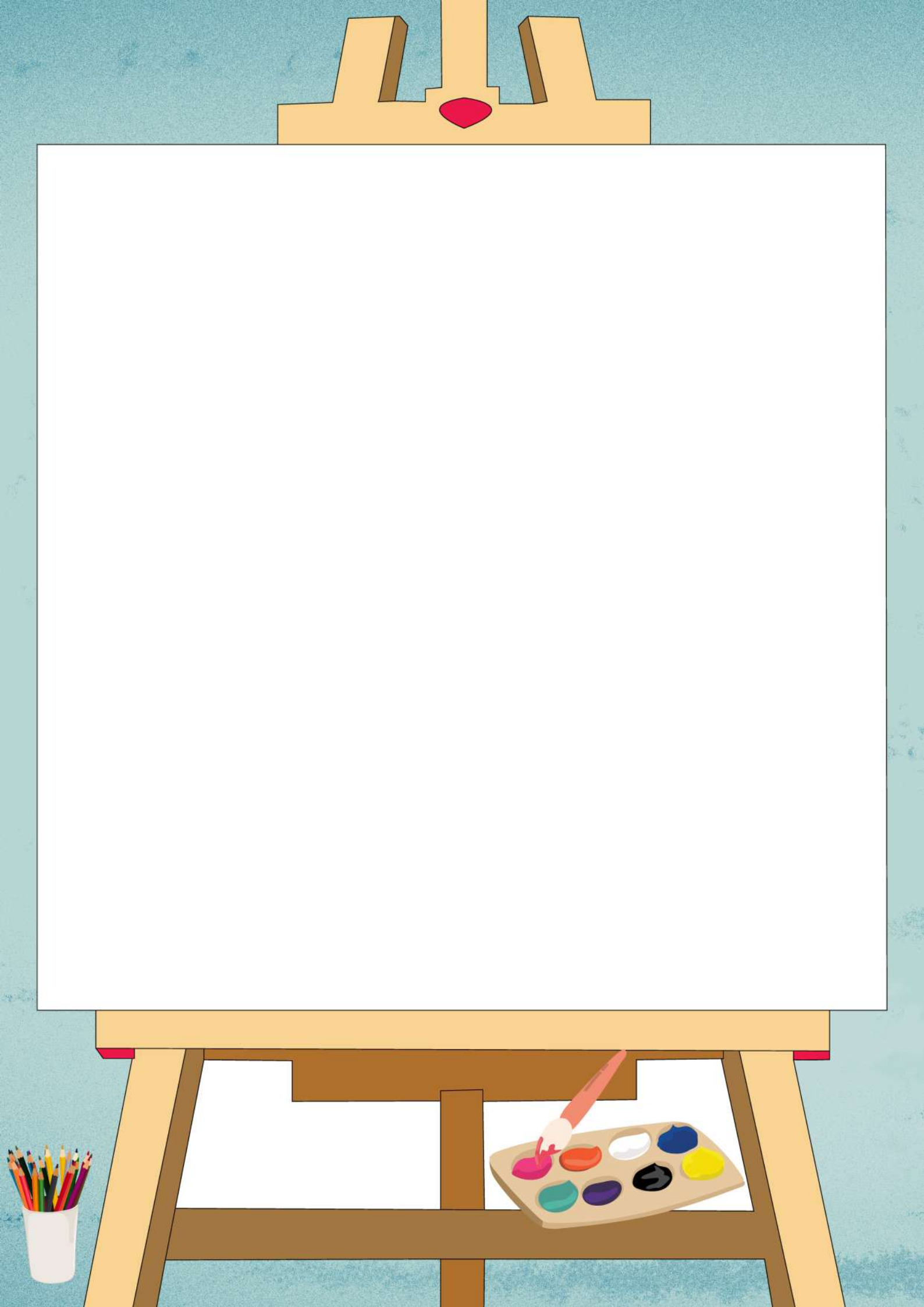

# Creative Cooking

Creativity in the Kingdom comes in many ways. Enjoy some creativity in the kitchen with your family and share what you make with someone!



## Jelly Treats

A friend shared this recipe with us a few years ago and now jelly treats are a favourite for a birthday party or just a fun snack! They are pretty healthy too as the gelatin is good for your gut. We love to use pomegranate juice but you can try other flavours too. This makes a nice and firm jelly and has a beautiful crunch with the grapes inside. You can even make a jelly cake with this recipe if you have a silicone mould to make it in.

### INGREDIENTS

1L pomegranate juice  
10 Tablespoons gelatin  
Grapes (optional)

### YOU WILL NEED

Gummy/Jelly moulds



### METHOD

#### Step 1:

Pour the juice into a saucepan. Measure out the gelatin and sprinkle it into the juice. Let it sit and bloom for a few minutes.

#### Step 2:

Warm the gelatin on low/medium heat and stir until dissolved. (Approximately 10 minutes)

#### Step 3:

Pour liquid into your gummy or jelly moulds. If you don't have any, even a plastic cup or small bowl could work too.

#### Step 4:

Add some washed grapes (optional) into the moulds and place them carefully into the freezer.

#### Step 5:

After 1-2 hours they should be set. Remove from the freezer and keep them in the fridge. Enjoy!

If you do want these for lunch boxes or to take out with you, keep them cool as they can melt if too warm.

STEP 3: Write your prayers on the sticky notes or write it on a piece of paper and put it in the box or peg them on - whatever your design is!

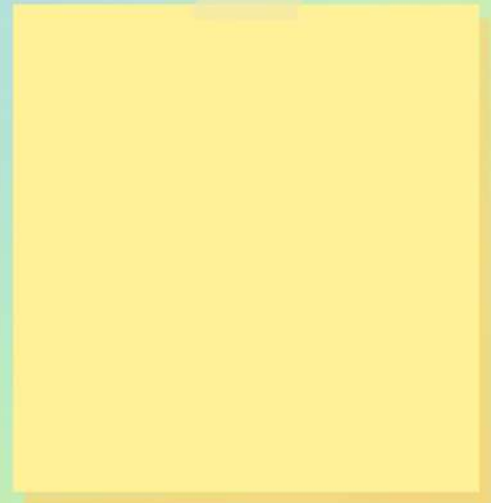
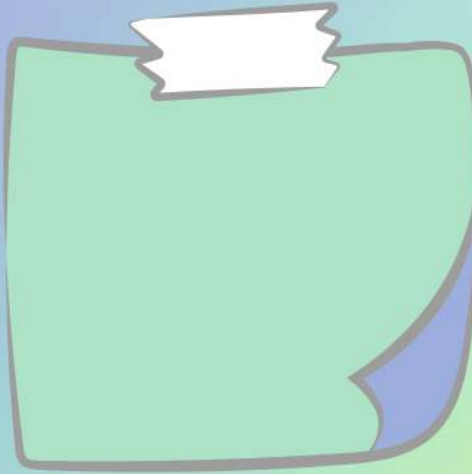

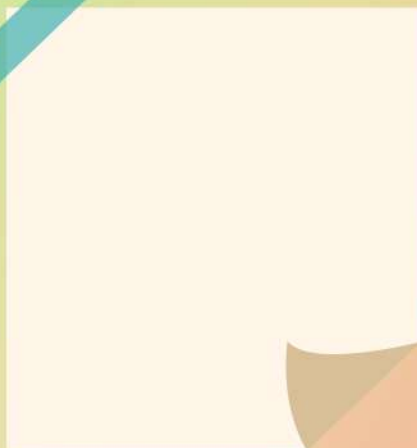

# Arky Arky Time



Spend some time as a family reflecting on the past year and thinking about the year ahead. Pray and thank God for all the good things that have happened in the last year. Thank Him for being with you through the tough things too. You might like to practice hearing from God by inviting Holy Spirit into this time. Ask Him for a special word for you for this coming year, ask Him for Bible verses and ask Him what things you need to do in 2025 to be prepared for what He has ahead of you. You might like to do this individually and then share together, or do it as a family - it's up to you!

# Fighting Your Battles

## For Kids and Teens



...the Lord your God  
is He who fights  
for you.  
Joshua 23:10.

You are God's beloved child! He loves you so much. He wants you to love Him too!

God wants to fight your battles with you, and for you. Let Him into the fight, He will always win! Jesus has already fought to the death for you. He already has won! The devil has already lost. With Jesus on your team, you can be sure of victory!

Some battles that you might invite Jesus into, are:

- battles for your family
- battles about who Jesus says you are, your identity in God
- battles for physical and spiritual healing
- battles in your mind and thoughts
- battles you feel like you just keep losing
- and battles that you have been fighting for a long time.



I encourage you, Kingdom Families, to ask Jesus into your battles. You might like to wake up and start your day by saying, "Jesus, today I want you to fight my battles with me and for me." You might declare this every day, or when you are in a situation where you need Jesus to fight for you. He will always fight for you when you ask.

Stand firm on God's word. You can declare straight from the Bible that, "No weapon formed against me will prosper, and every tongue which rises up against me, You will condemn..." (Isaiah 54:17).

Invite Jesus to fight your battles with you and for you...He has already won!



# Activation

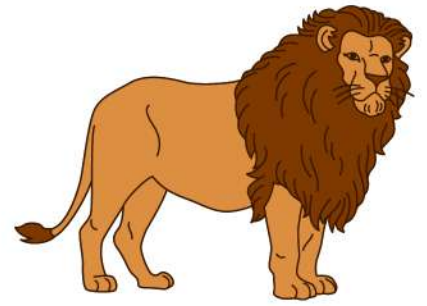

# Daniel

Daniel was part of a noble family in Jerusalem. When he had finished his studies, he would serve the king of Judah. While Daniel was still training, King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon invaded their country. King Nebuchadnezzar instructed Ashpenaz, a trusted man of the king, to gather the wisest, smartest and most good-looking noblemen of Jerusalem to take to Babylon in exile. These exiles would be taught for many years, then they would serve the king.

Daniel was one of those taken, as well as Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah. When they arrived in Babylon, they were given Babylonian names; Hananiah received the name Shadrach; Mishael became Meshach and Azariah became Abed-Nego. Daniel was given the name Belteshazzar which means 'may the gods protect his life'. It was a very significant name. But Daniel knew that his true identity was as Daniel, which means 'God is my judge'.

All of the exiles were given meat and wine to eat so that they were healthy. Daniel knew that the food had been sacrificed to false gods. He knew that eating this food was like worshipping their idols. Daniel and his friends asked Ashpenaz, who was in charge of the exiles, if they could eat vegetables and drink water. Ashpenaz said they could try it for ten days, but if they were unhealthy and weak, then they would have to eat the food from the king's table, sacrificed to false gods. After ten days, they were healthier than all the other exiles!

He knew that his true identity was as Daniel, which means 'God is my judge'.





God gave Daniel the interpretation of many dreams. He gave interpretations to some of King Nebuchadnezzar's dreams. One night King Nebuchadnezzar had a dream; when he woke he asked all his dream interpreters what it meant, but he wouldn't even tell them what the dream was! The king ordered all his dream interpreters, including Daniel and his friends, to be killed.

Daniel asked God to tell him what the dream was and the interpretation for it. Guess what? God did the impossible, he showed Daniel what the dream was and gave him the interpretation. King Nebuchadnezzar was shocked and amazed, and decided that all the interpreters could live.

Later in Daniel's life, a new king was on the throne of Babylon, King Darius. King Darius was a fair king and made good laws. He made a law that all laws made must be kept and cannot be changed.

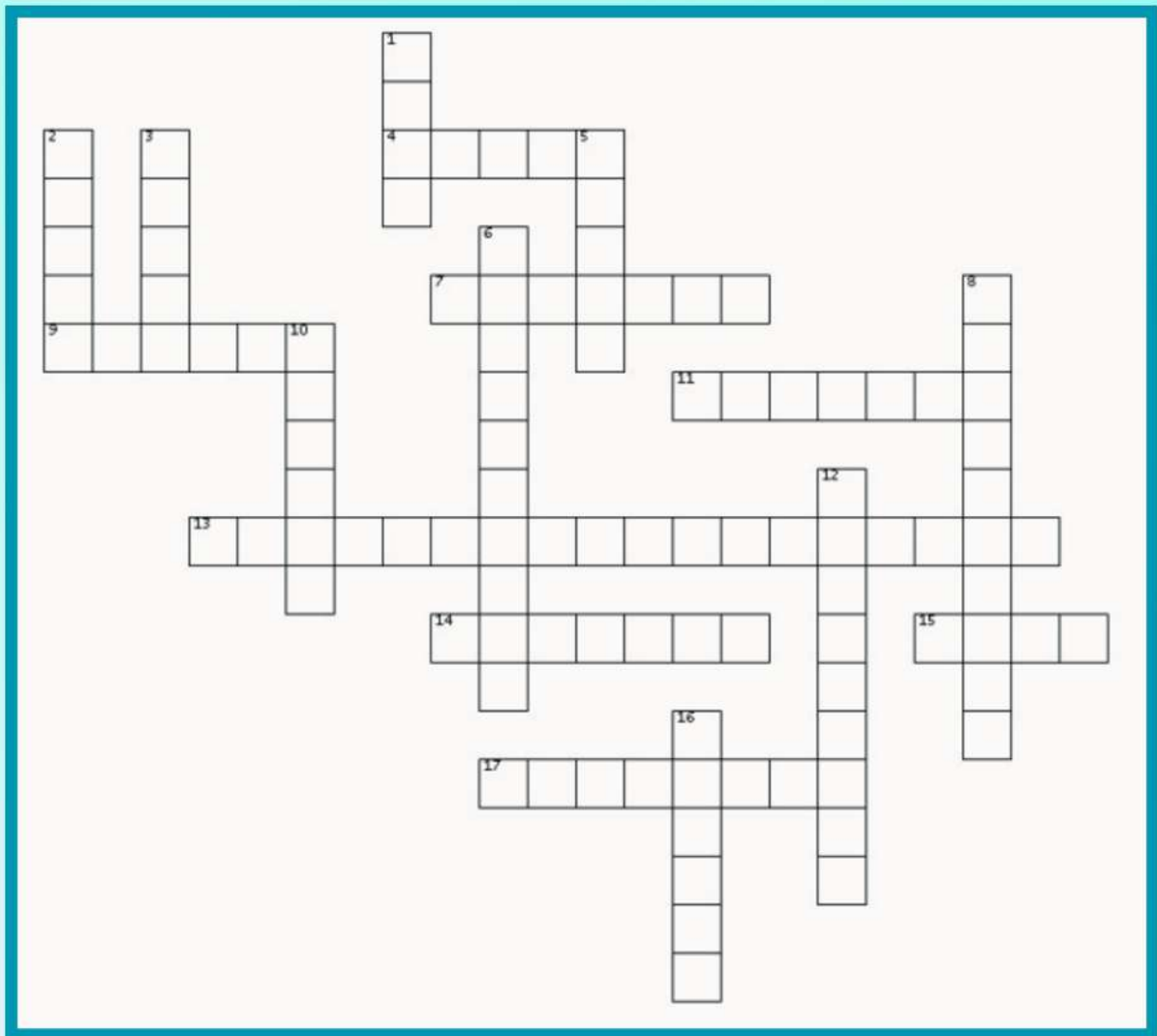
King Darius made Daniel the second in command over all of Babylon! The king's other advisors were jealous of Daniel, so they plotted to get rid of him. They could find nothing wrong about him, he was a good and smart man. The only weakness they found, was that he worshiped the Most High God. So the king's advisors wrote a law that no one could petition anyone except King Darius for thirty days; this included praying. If they broke the law, they would be thrown into the lion's den!

Daniel was a faithful man and did not stop praying. He was caught, arrested and thrown into the lion's den. King Darius didn't want Daniel to be thrown into the den, he hoped that Daniel's God would save him. God sent an angel to shut the mouths of the lions. Daniel was saved! Daniel trusted God to save him. God saw Daniel's faith and saved him.

Daniel remained faithful and righteous even when faced with all kinds of trials! Because he honoured God, God honoured Daniel. To read more about Daniel, see the book of Daniel in the Bible. To find out more about the Jew's exile to Babylon, you can read the book of Jeremiah.

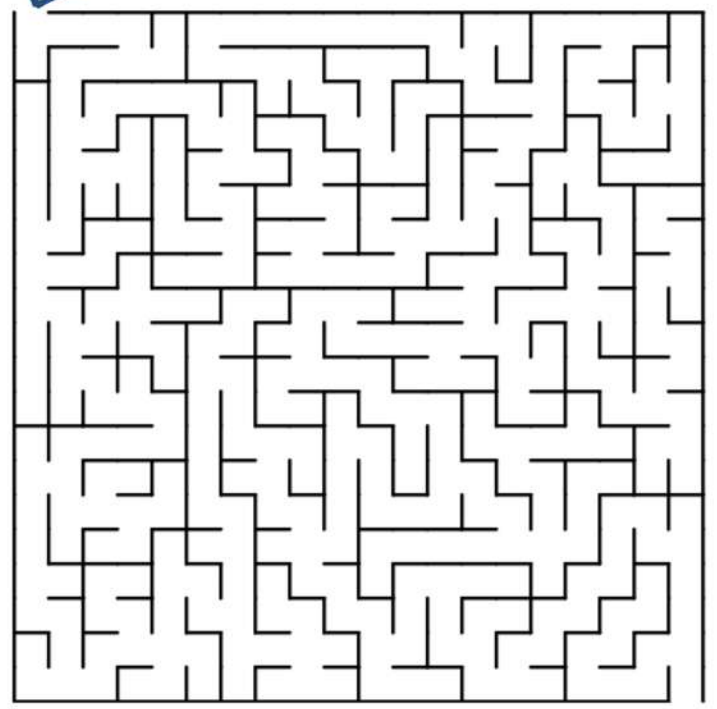
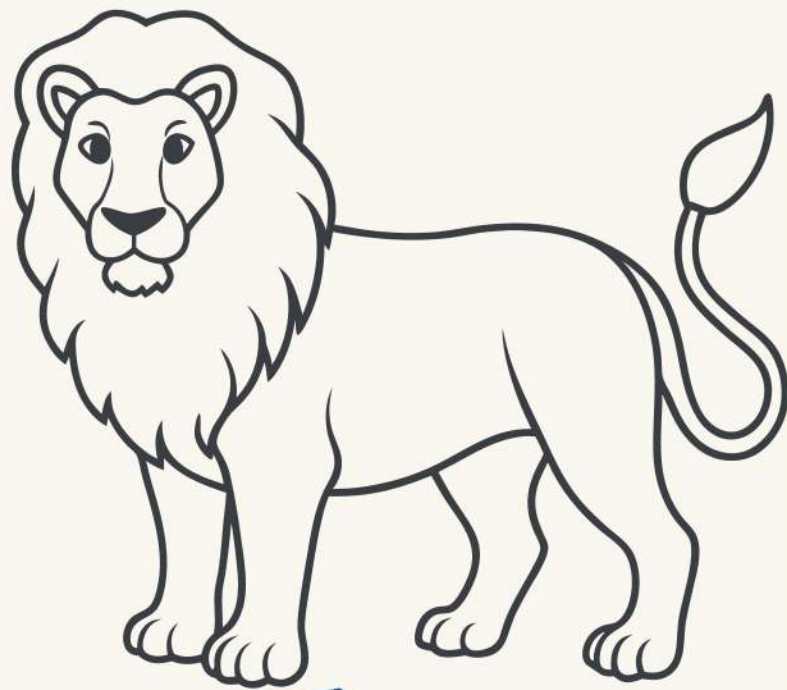

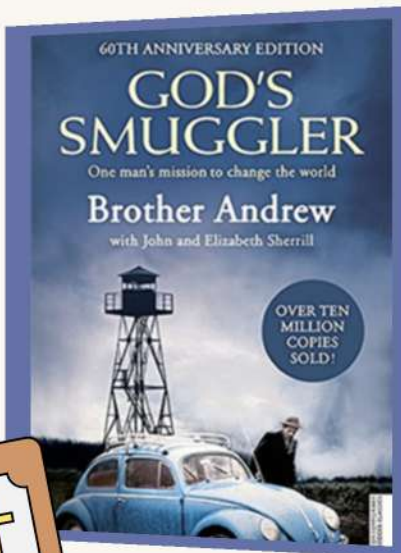

Brother Andrew shares the true story of his childhood, conversion and his ministry to persecuted Christians behind the Iron Curtain. Brother Andrew learns to trust God with everything from soap to crossing borders with smuggled Bibles, to donations to fund millions of Bibles being shared in communist countries.

While full of adventure, there are some sensitive and heavy topics covered that may not be appropriate for young children. He shares some stories of the things he did before he met Jesus, as well as stories of how some of the Christians are persecuted.

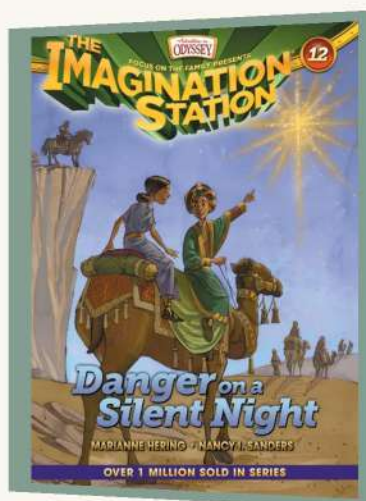
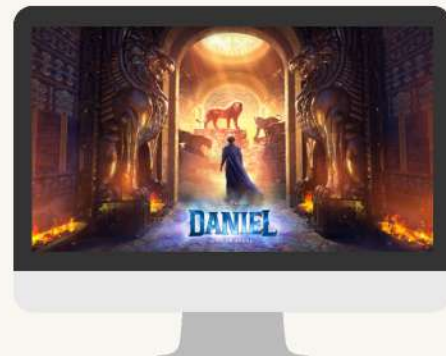
## Daniel



Sight and Sound productions has created a fabulous theatre production of the Biblical story of Daniel, and recorded it for viewing. Available via subscription or pay per view, but we encourage you to keep an eye out for free viewings occasionally. The sets and costumes are amazing and the storyline and music is captivating.

The production tells the journey of Daniel going into exile in Babylon, Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-Nego in the fiery furnace through to Daniel in the Lion's Den! It also covers King Nebuchadnezzar's dreams, his period of madness and restoration, King Belshazzar's short reign and fall from grace with King Darius' takeover.

We enjoyed watching this together as a family and reading about Daniel in the Bible; great discussions were had! Recommended for all ages with parental guidance (it has some scarier scenes in Babylon as there are false gods and shows King Nebuchadnezzar's madness which is represented well but may be a little scary for younger audiences).

Two cousins, Beth and Patrick travel back in time to see the first Christmas. Beth arrives in the palace to find out that King Herod wants to try to kill baby Jesus, while Patrick is travelling with the wise men. Eventually they find each other. There's a troublesome soldier named Brutus who follows them to baby Jesus but all ends well. Beth and Patrick learn things along the way, especially about the true meaning of the first Christmas.

Book 12 of the series is an intense and good read written by Marianne Hering and Nancy I. Sanders. Recommended for ages 8+

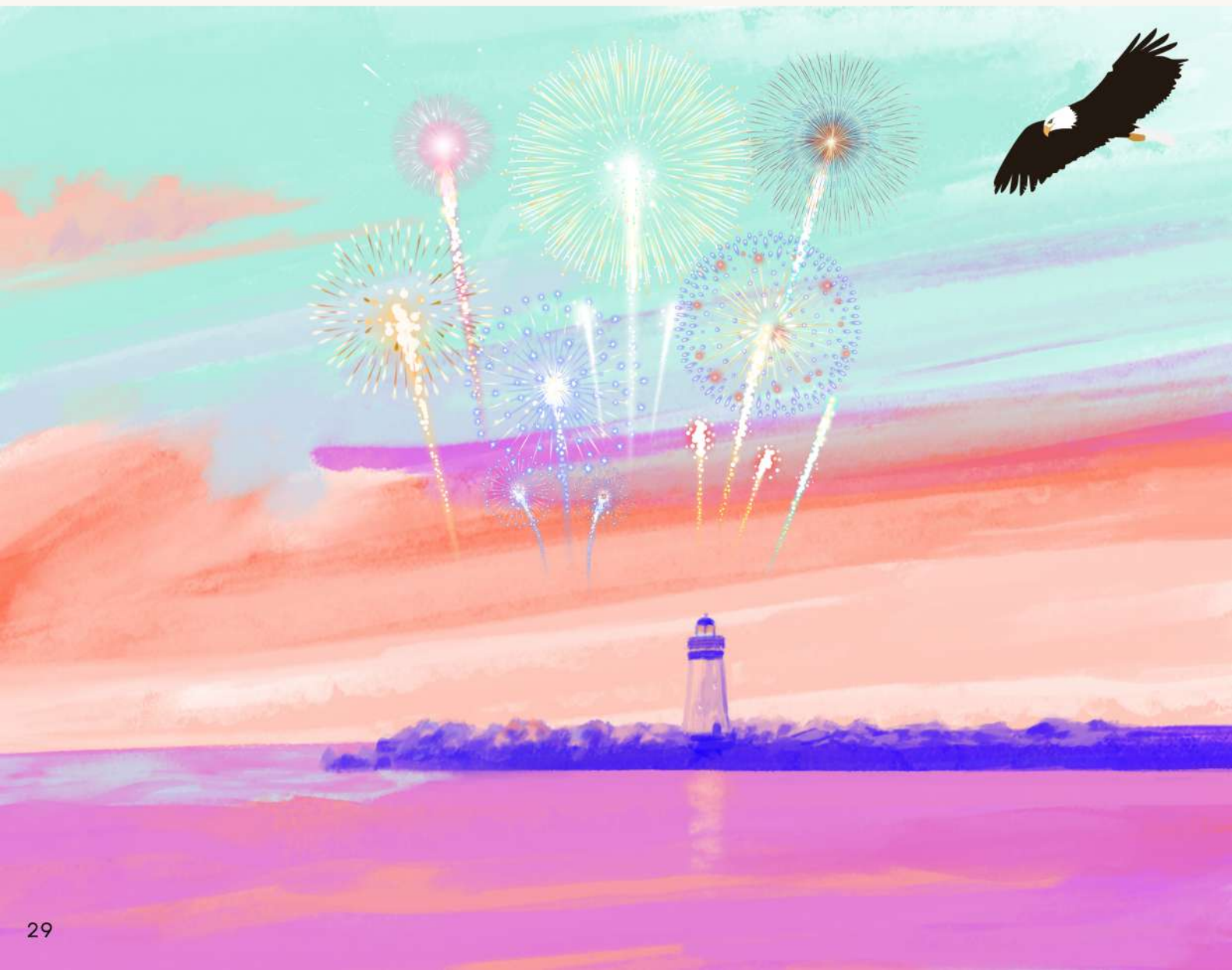
