# Wulftown Print and DPI (Digitally Projected Images ) Competitions

## Rules

For the fun and advancement of all our members!

1. Wulftown full paid up members are all eligible to enter our Wulftown print competitions.
  2. Entries must be members own work and not a collaboration with other photographers
  3. In order to enter the monthly competition members must have attended 50% of the meetings in the competition month.
  4. A judge for each competition will be nominated by the Competitions Manager.
  5. All club competitions will be divided into 3 sections,  
Bronze, Silver and Gold
  6. The competition year is to run from January to November inclusive. December is awards month, with awards for the overall winners though the year presented with a winner's trophy.
  7. The maximum number of images for any competition will be 3 per member. An exception will be a competition for 'three of a kind'.  
The club admin reserves the right to change the number of entries allowed.
  8. Wulftown competitions .....
- A specific subject will be stated for each monthly competition.
  - All images entered will be judged and given a mark during the competition night.
  - Trophies will be presented in December to the members who accumulate the most points in excess of 15 marks in each competition section during that year.



9. The following points system will be used for our monthly print competitions.

- Prints will be marked out of 20. These marks will form the basis of a League table.
  - All scores will be recorded and added to the Leader board and League table
  - The monthly competition marks will be added together to decide the winner of each section for the year.
  - Members will stay within their competition section for the Competition year i.e. from January to November. New members will be allocated a section by the competitions' manager after consultation with the new member.
  - The final league tables of the competition year will also be used to promote members from one section to another. The top four in the Beginner and the top two in the Intermediate sections being considered for promoted to the Intermediate and Advanced sections respectively.
  - The Admin team also reserves the right to move a member between sections if they believe it is beneficial for the member and in the best interest of the competition.

10. All print entries should be handed to the competitions team 7days before the competition and DPI should be sent to [Wulftown@mail.com](mailto:Wulftown@mail.com) on the Monday of the Competition week.

11. All print entries must have a fully completed Wulftown issued label attached to the back of the mount.

12. The Admin team may withdraw an entry if they believe it to be:

- (a) outside the theme of the competition.
- (b) Offensive or inappropriate in a sexual, political, religious, etc nature.
- (c) Not the entrants original work.
- (d) oversized mount.

13.The judge's decision is final.

14.Once an image has been used in a club monthly competition, it cannot be entered into any future club monthly competitions in any format within that same competition year.

An image may be re-entered, if changed from colour to monochrome or vice-versa.

15.Print competition entries must be mounted, and have a maximum mount size of 16" x 20" inches (400x500mm),

The Image size and placement within the mount is at the authors discretion.

For DPI competitions the file size must be no bigger than 1400 in width for landscape or 1050 pixels in height for portrait images.

16. Copyright of all images making up an entry must rest with the entrant, images containing 'clip art' or 'stock photos' are not permitted.

**Note:** Changes to our rules can be made for a competition if the club admin, or competitions manager believe it necessary.

Changes will be made known at least 14 days before a competition.

Print your image art, mount for presentation, and help your fellow togs to improve by discussion. Having loads of fun at an enjoyable
