It's impossible to miss the devastation that occurred in Florida, Georgia, Tennessee, South Carolina and North Cleaning Kits

AKA FLOOD BUCKETS last week. Even as I write this, Florida is about to get hit again with a storm

even worse than the one before.

Remember back in 2012 when the Jersey Shore was turned inside out by Superstorm Sandy? Remember the destruction and the pain? Remember how it felt like recovery just went on forever? Remember the aid that was sent from all over to help?

Now it's our turn to be the aid.

As United Methodists, we are part of a large connectional system and churches all over the globe have begun to respond in supplying food, water, and other supplies. As the areas are deemed safe enough, we will get in and start the recovery process. We get to participate in that work right here and now. It's possible we may be able to send a team down south in time, but for now, we get to participate the United Methodist way.

One of the biggest ways we do that is by building cleaning kits (sometimes known as flood buckets) and hygiene kits. Over the next few weeks we will be collecting items and funds to build the buckets. You can find the list of what is needed at the links below. It is very important that if you are donating items, you donate the item EXACTLY as it is described on the list. Otherwise, we won't fit everything in the bucket.

You can drop off supplies at the church during office hours or Sunday mornings. We will plan an assembly day in the near future.
