



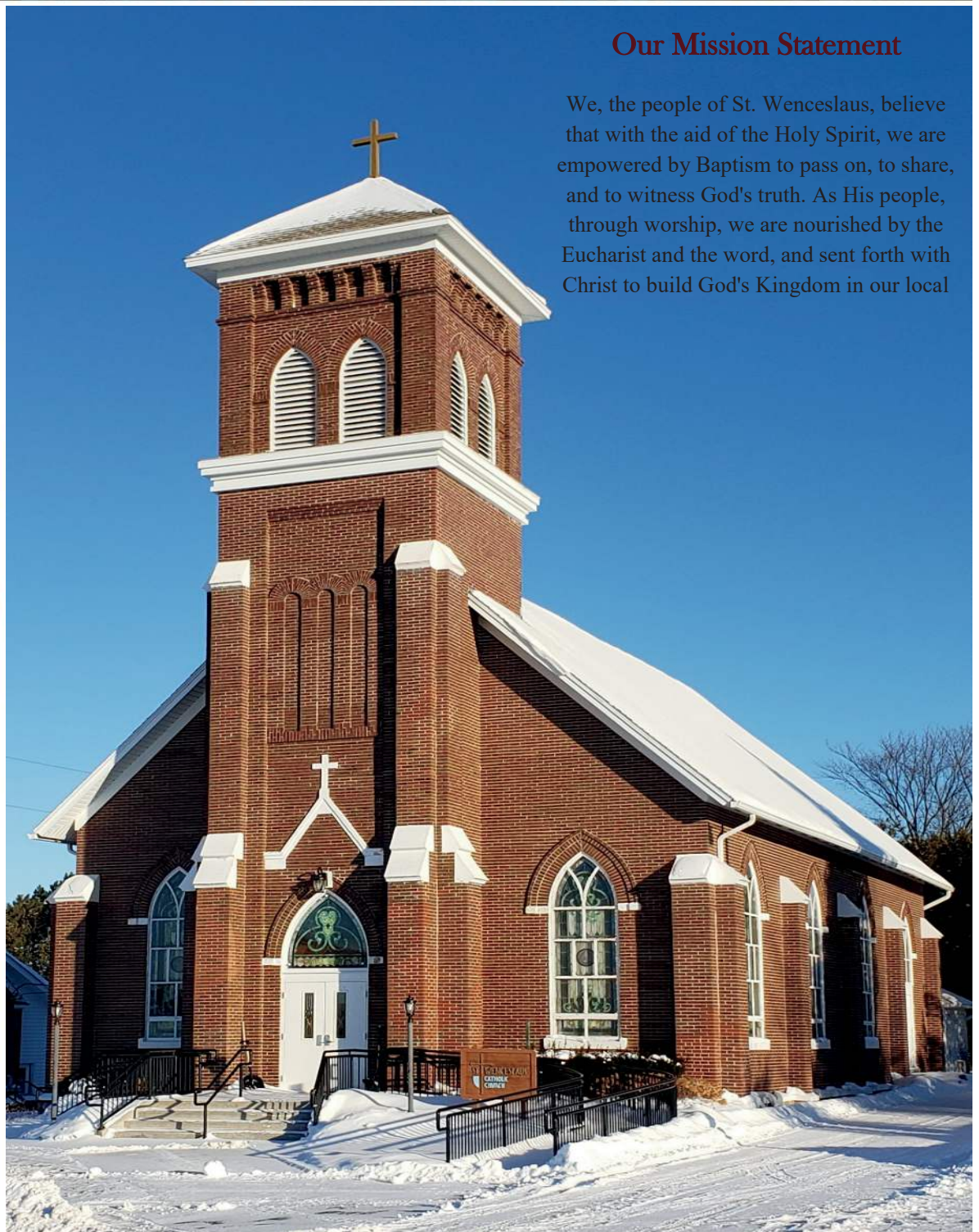

In today's liturgy, Matthew 3:13-17, John the Baptist baptizes Jesus Christ. Upon doing so, the heavens open up and the Spirit of God descends upon Him in the form of a dove. And a voice from heaven saying: "This is my beloved Son with whom I am well pleased."

When we are baptized, original sin is taken away, the sin of Adam and Eve, our first parents. God the Father is pleased with us for now we have become children of God. We are now heirs to the Kingdom of God. And the Holy Spirit descends on us as well.
