## Dear Fellow Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, Luke 15:1-3, 11-32, we read of Jesus telling the parable of The Prodigal Son. We are aware of the three main characters, The Father, The Younger Son, and the Older Brother. The younger brother, who insulted his father by asking for his inheritance, took his possessions and left his father, left his upbringing, left his homeland, and left his country, He chose to go into a new area and sought personal gratification, self glory. It was all about him, self centered, until there was nothing left. At the bottom, homeless, penny less, he looks back to His Father for security.

The older brother stayed home, jealous and self-righteous. He was cold yet his **behavior** was proper. He did all the right things. He expected to get his inheritance because he stayed home. He paid his dues. He was physically there. He too, loved things.

The Father is the most important person in the parable. He loves his sons, regardless of their affection for him. The younger son returns home not because of love for the father, but because of his personal need. The older son who was physically there, did not respect his father's actions. Neither son had any idea how much the father loved them.

Jesus told the parable in hopes that we might get a better understanding, a better awareness, a better appreciation of the love God has for us. He loves us even when we go our own way, leave our Christian way of life, seek a self-centered life, live for our own pleasure. Or we may do all the right things for our own glory. See page 2.


