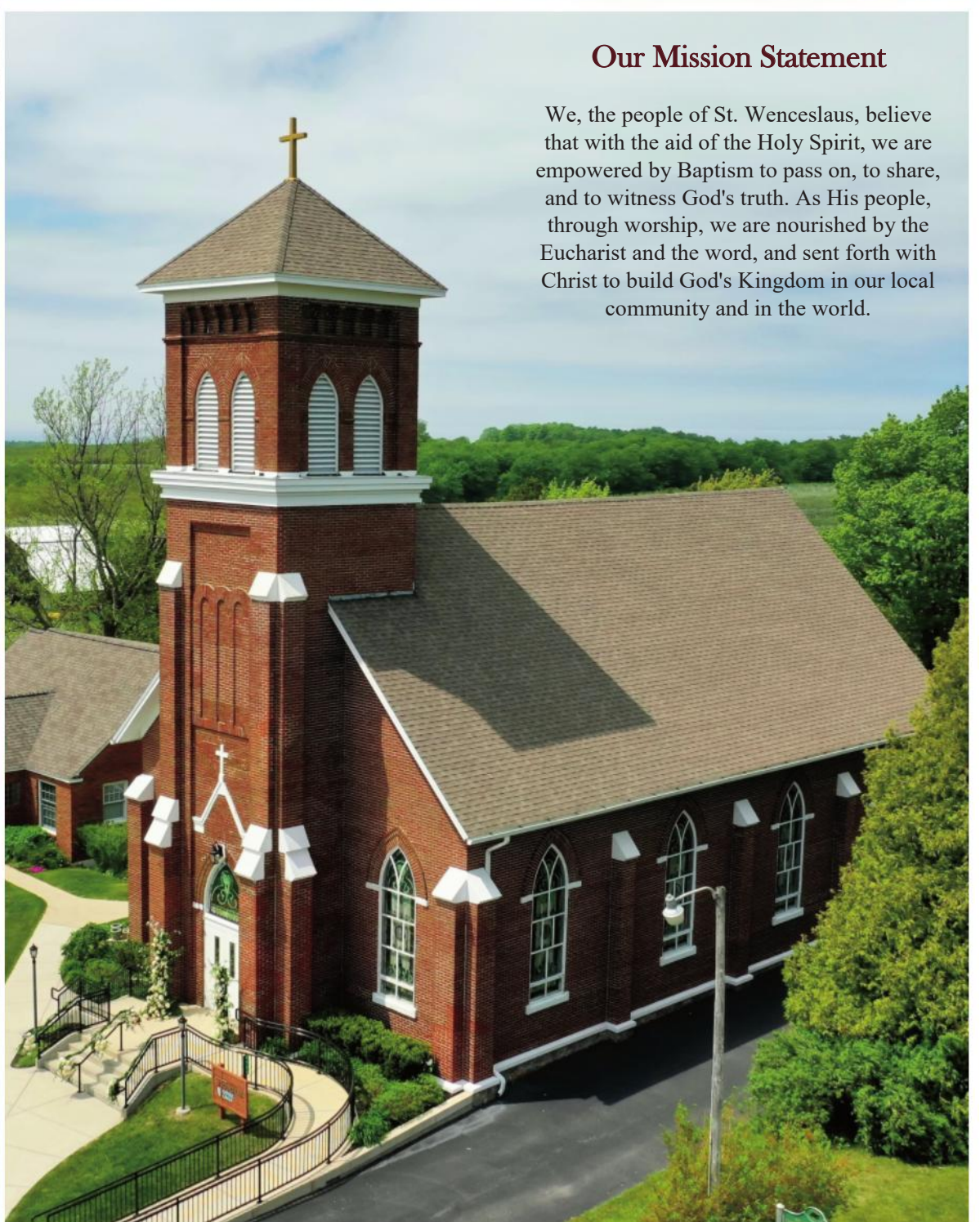

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. In today's Gospel, Luke 19:11b-17, Jesus speaks to the crowds about the Kingdom of God and healed those who needed to be cured. It was late in the day, so the twelve approached Jesus and asked that He dismiss them for they were in a deserted place. Jesus asked them to feed them. They replied that they had only 5 loaves and 2 fish, they could not feed 5,000 men.

Jesus asked that they sit in groups of 50. Then He blessed the fish and loaves and had the twelve feed the people. They ate and were all satisfied. In the end there was 12 baskets of fragments left. They had more than enough.

Jesus is always more generous than we can expect. He is more concerned about others than Himself. He was concerned about the crowds physical well being. He gave to all who came, not questioning anyone. Jesus initiated the giving. The crowd responded by sitting peacefully together and accepting His gift. When all were in the prescience of Jesus, all was well for a moment. All sat in harmony with each other.

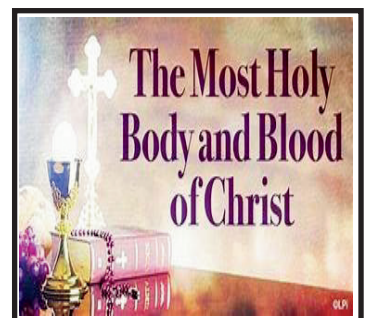
This is what Jesus wishes for us. That He be with us, and we allow Him to feed us. He wants so much to be with us that He offers us His own body and blood in the form of bread and wine. It is out of love for us that He continues to come to us. He wants us all to live in Harmony.

How do we respond to His invitation? Do we seek Him often in the Eucharist? He is there every day. Do we acknowledge Him in the Eucharist? Do we Believe He is truly present in the form of Bread and Wine? Are we respectful when we receive? Jesus is truly here. Welcome Him. We will all be better for it.
