In today's readings Jesus is on the cross. The rulers ask for proof of who He is. One of the criminals challenge Him as well. The other criminal rebukes him saying; "Have you no fear of God, for you are subject to the same condemnation? We have been condemned justly, but this man has done nothing criminal." Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom." Jesus replied, "Today you will be with me in Paradise."

In the Mass, in the Eucharist, this scene is rein-acted. There are those who expect great signs. There are those who have no respect for Jesus. There are those who want to bargain with Christ, if you are, do some thing for me. There are those who just want to be with Christ.

Those who want to follow Him. Those who want to be with Christ, follow Him, accept Him in the breaking of the bread. Recognize that He has forgiven us. That He is physically with us. Regardless of our past, He invites us to be with Him in Paradise, to be part of His Kingdom. To have a personal relationship with God the Father.

Christ does not forget any of us. He calls us to himself at every moment of our lives. He calls us in our moments of suffering. He calls us in our moments of joy. Today's solemnity reminds us of all that. Christ the King remembers us. And that gives us the confident joy of the redeemed. God does not forget. We too can pray; "Remember me when you come into your Kingdom!"
