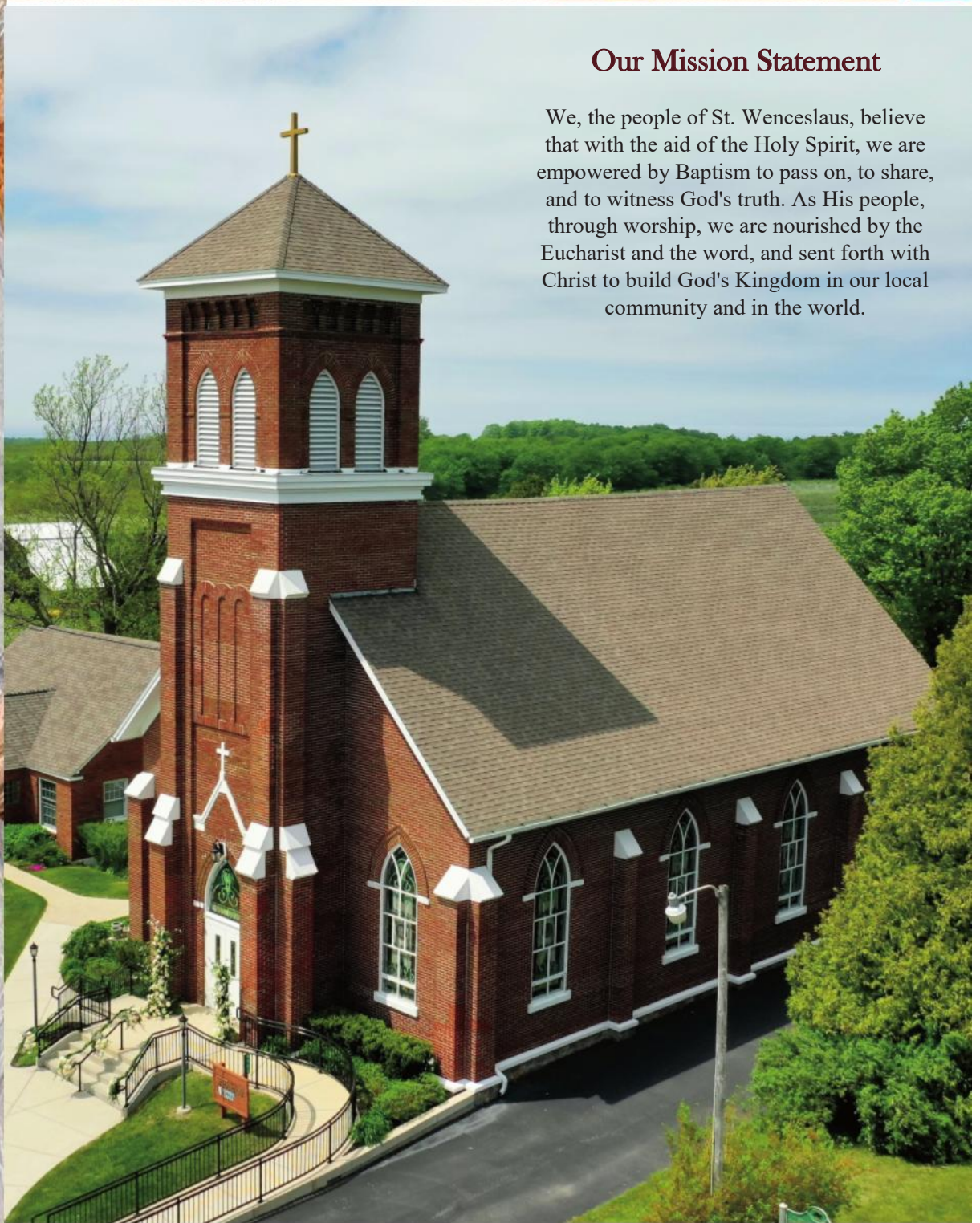

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate Saint Peter and Saint Paul, Apostles Day. In today's Gospel: Jesus asks His disciples who do people say He is? They respond with, "Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." He asks them, who do you say that I am.
