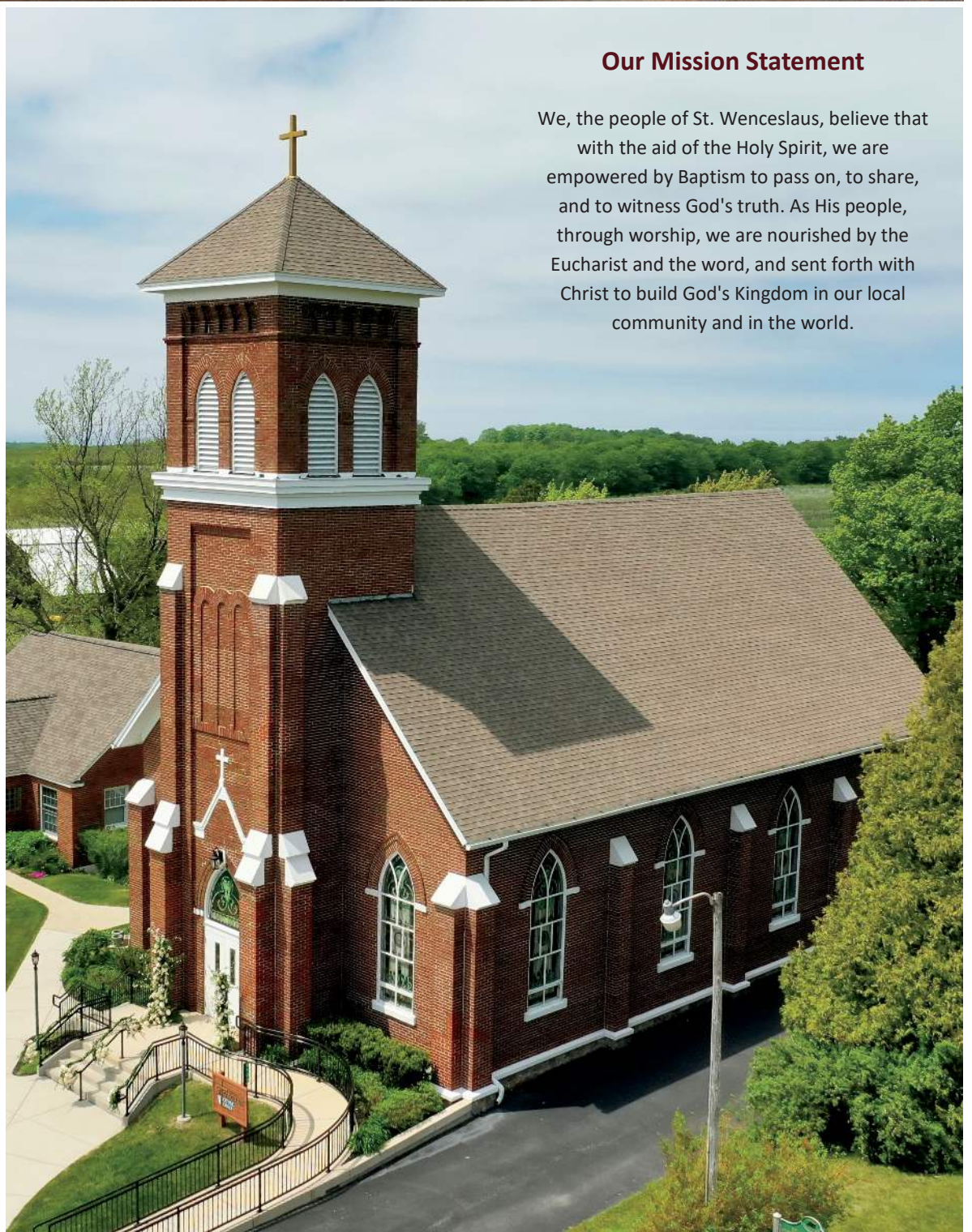

**Dear Friends in Christ,**

In today's liturgy, from Matthew 10:26–33, Jesus tells the twelve, "Fear no one". Our Lord reminds the Apostles that they need to stand with Him and not be afraid. There will be many obstacles in our lives, many disappointments, even heartbreaks, but trust in the Lord. We all have moments where we question whether the Lord really knows what is going on, or truly cares about what will happen to us.
