



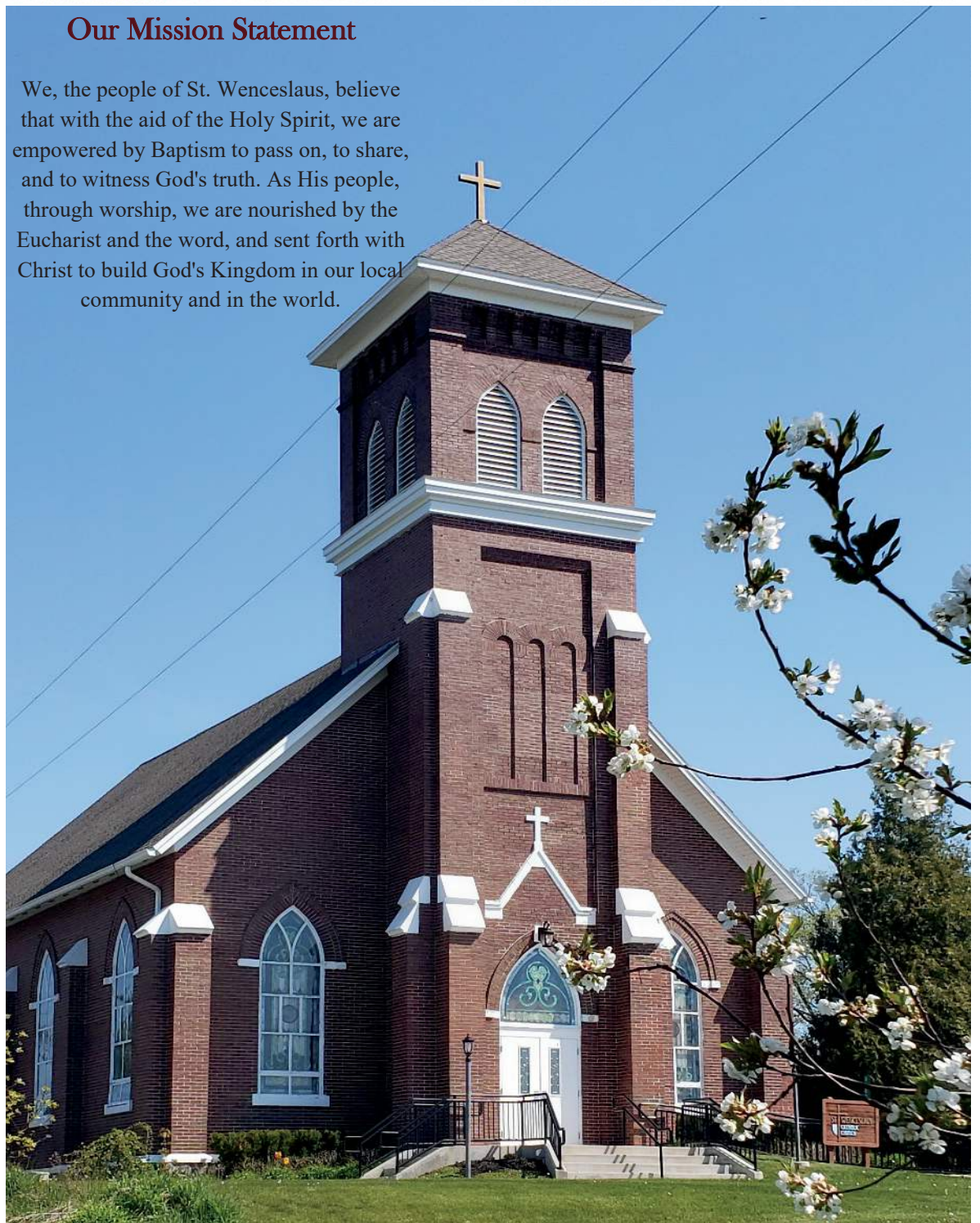

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today's liturgy, from John 20:19-23, tells of Jesus appearing to the disciples on the first day of the week after His Crucifixion. They were hiding due to fear of the Jews. The doors were locked when Jesus appeared in the room and said to them; "Peace be with you." The disciples rejoiced when they saw Him. Jesus shows them His hands and side. He then says again; "Peace be with you." He then breaths on them and says: "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."

Jesus came to His disciples; He came to them in their fear, their confusion, in their aloneness, in their distress, in their sense of loss. He sought them out, even though they had deserted Him. They had their own idea of what the Kingdom was going to be and how they would fit into God's plan. We are very much the same way as to our way of doing things.

Jesus still comes to us, regardless of what we may have done. Not only does He come to us, but He sends us a helper, the Holy Spirit, to console and comfort us, to forgive us, and direct us on our way. The way of Jesus Christ is the only way. Jesus sent the disciples, He sends us as well, to share the good news. He wants to be part of our life, to walk with us, to instill in us his way. That is to give us insights into life, to love God and Neighbor, and to forgive as He has forgiven us.
