

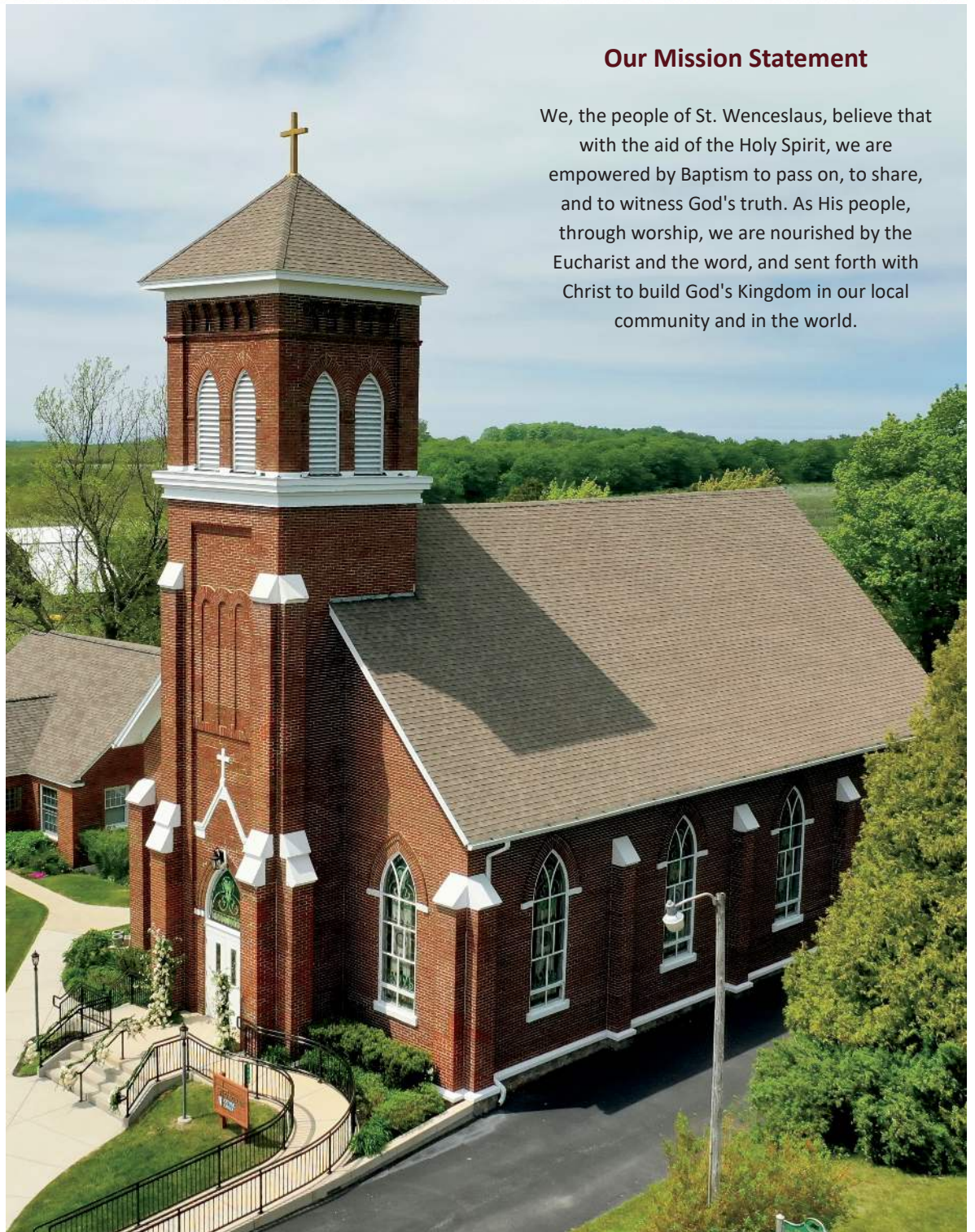

Dear Friends in Christ,

In today's liturgy, from Matthew 10:37-42, Jesus tells the apostles that they must have their priorities in proper order, that He must be number one in our lives. He must come before family, friends and things. We must always focus on His plan, for He sees the whole picture, we see only a small part of the landscape. When we focus on Jesus, and look at life through His eyes, hear through His ears, we will become more aware of the situation and other possibilities as a solution.

St. Wenceslaus Happenings

Beginning July 1, under the Diocese of Gaylord's Pastoral Plan 2026, St. Wenceslaus Church will become a limited-use church and will merge with St. Mary of Lake Leelanau. We will no longer celebrate weekly Sunday or daily Masses in this sacred place.

As a limited-use church, St. Wenceslaus will continue to celebrate our patronal feast Mass on September 28 each year. Baptisms, weddings and funerals may also be celebrated here for parishioners and with the approval of the pastor of St. Mary Lake Leelanau.

We know that today carries deep meaning for many. This church has been a place of prayer, sacraments, memories and faithful witness across generations. Feelings of sadness, grief and even loss are natural and are held prayerfully within the heart of our Church.

While our worship here changes, our faith, our relationships and our belonging in the Church do not end. Our receiving parish – St. Mary Lake Leelanau – warmly welcomes you into their community. St. Mary Lake Leelanau celebrates Mass at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and at 7:30 a.m., 9:15 a.m., and 11:00 a.m. on Sunday.

Sacramental records for baptisms, marriages and funerals previously celebrated at St.

Wenceslaus will be maintained by St. Mary Lake Leelanau. Those needing records or copies are asked to contact the office of St. Mary Lake Leelanau directly. St. Mary Lake Leelanau will also be caring for our church, grounds and cemetery.

As we entrust this transition to the Lord, we give thanks for all that has been, we grieve what is changing, and we place our hope in Christ, who remains with us always.

Tuesday: "The Hour of Power" St. Wenceslaus from 4 p.m.-5 p.m. to pray *The Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet and Novena in Honor of the Most Holy Face of Jesus* for God's solution to our situation. This will continue until July 7th.

There will be Coffee, Rolls, and Juice this Sunday as we gather after Mass to have the Raffle drawing on the parish grounds. In the event of rain, the drawing will be in the Church basement. Please plan to stay and visit with friends and guests. Thanks to Joel, Lara, and Andrew Sweitzer for hosting last week.
