

Hillsdale Hobo Hootenanny Highlights, 2025



Prepare for the Spring Rise

Now that the temperature in Michigan is increasing and spring is around the corner, llamas, alpacas, and their owners are emerging from under the cover of barns, straw bedding and blankets. Another critter is emerging as well – intestinal parasites. Warm weather and moisture create the perfect environment for hatching of parasite eggs in manure piles and maturation of larvae to infective stages.

Camelids are notorious for hiding signs of disease until there is a significant problem. Screening our llamas and alpacas for signs of a high parasite burden is beneficial to identifying problems early.



One method of screening is called the **Five Point Check.** This involves checking five different areas on the camelid for potential signs of parasitism and only takes about one minute.

1) Eyes – perform a FAMACHA score. This test assesses the conjunctiva of the eye for signs of anemia by comparing the color to a FAMACHA score card. Haemonchus contortus or barberpole worm is often called "the silent killer" because it can cause anemia in camelids. Anemia can be the only sign of parasitism by H. contortus.



A FAMACHA score should be performed using the cover, push, pull, pop method. Simply pulling down the eyelid often shows a paler score than the true assessment would show. A score of 1 and 2 out of 5 is considered ideal. Anemia would be considered at a score of 4 or 5 out of 5. You can learn more about performing a FAMACHA score correctly at wormx.info




2) Jaw – assess the lower aspect of the jaw for a fluctuant to soft swelling. It would be symmetrical and often sits between the two jaw bones. This is an indicator of low protein. Protein helps retain fluid within the blood vessels. When parasites consume our animals' protein, it leads to pooling of fluid in gravity dependent places such as the lower jaw, brisket, and prepuce.

- **3) Body** conduct a body condition score of your llama or alpaca. This is best assessed by placing your hand over the spine just behind the withers. The spine should create a 90 degree angle between your thumb and index finger. If it is wider, your animal is over-conditioned and if it is narrower, your animal is under-conditioned. An underconditioned animal may be suffering from parasitism.
- **4) Diarrhea** does your llama or alpaca have diarrhea? Normal camelid stool should be formed into individual pellets sometimes with a tip at one end. Diarrhea could range from clumped balls of pellets to soft cow-patties to watery stool.






5) Fleece – this can be more difficult to assess in camelids, but evidence of dull or brittle fiber, poor fiber regrowth after shearing or "wool break" where the fleece is lost at the level of the skin, could be evidence of parasitism.

Keep in mind that these indicators do not diagnose a parasite problem. For example, there are multiple conditions that can cause weight loss. If multiple points on the Five Point Check indicate that parasites may be a problem, then it would be wise to assess that animal further by having a fecal egg count performed.

In Michigan, it is recommended to screen your llamas and alpacas every 3-4 weeks during "ideal parasite weather," or when it is warm and wet. Extreme heat and dry weather decrease survivability of parasites on your pastures. In addition, freezing temperatures destroy many of the eggs and larvae in manure packs. Consequently, parasite screening can be performed less frequently during these seasons.

The Shear Necessities: Picking the Perfect Llama Cut



Picking the Perfect Cut

Spring is here! With the temperatures increasing, shearing season is upon us in order to keep our camelids cool and comfortable. Every year we get the question "What kind of cut should my llama get?"

Barrel Cut Also Known As: Mid Body Shear

Barrel cuts are common for younger animals and for animals that are being shown. It opens up that space around their belly to keep them cool, and gives them a 'cleaner' look. Barrel cuts also allow you to better accentuate the animal for show.






This is also a nice cut for older animals, as it opens up that belly area while leaving enough fiber for protection when the temperatures began to go down.

Open-Hip Cut Also Known As: Lion Cut

Open Hip cuts, also called a Lion Cut, is a common cut where you shear the mid section and down the llamas hips.





This is a great cut for show animals with heavy fiber and intact males.

Barrel cuts are common for younger animals and for animals that are being shown. It opens up that space around their belly to keep them cool, and gives them a 'cleaner' look. Barrel cuts also allow you to better accentuate the animal for show.



Argentine Cut Also Known As: Partial Body, Open Shoulder




This is also a nice cut for older animals, as it opens up that belly area while leaving enough fiber for protection when the temperatures began to go down.

Full Body Cut

Full body cuts are essential every 2-3 years in medium to heavy wool animals. Other fiber types need full body as well, but it is at the discretion of the owner based on the animal itself. Preventing hotspots is essential and this is a good way to do that.





This is also a nice cut for heavy wool animals for the summer that gives them a great deal of relief, especially pregnant females.
