### There will be Leaping and Limbo fun classes held at the end of the day Saturday!

Note: Saturday's show begins with Showmanship and will be followed by Halter classes. Obstacle classes will begin directly after halter concludes and will resume Sunday morning. Fiber classes will start Saturday morning after exhibitor meeting and run until the end of halter. Please be attentive to our desire to move this show along and have someone help you show if necessary.

**MLA Membership discount** is \$10.00 off of EACH STALL. Stalls are \$40 each but reduced to \$30 with an MLA membership. This is for all MLA Shows!!!

**Health Certificates and microchips are required for all animals from out of state.** Animals from within MI do not need Health Certificates.

**Rules/Guidelines** New 23rd edition ALSA Handbook. Exhibitor's must be the registered owners & make entry in the exact names as shown on the registration certificate. All llamas must be ILR registered, except animals for youth classes or non-breeders with a vet certificate. Non breeders without registration must be accompanied by a vet certificate verifying.

**For performance classes**. One entry/youth in all youth performance classes. An animal can only go through each OB, PR, or Pack class one time. Jr. Youth: 7-11, Intermediate: 12-14, Senior: 15-19 as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. A Youth who turns 7 during the year can show as of his/her birthday. Include ALSA and ILR numbers for each youth handler. ALSA Guidelines will be followed for pack classes.

**Produce Of Dam**: 2 offspring from the same dam.

**Get Of Sire**-3 animals with the same sire, out of 2 different dams. All Get of Sire and Produce entries must show in appropriate halter classes.

If not the owner of Sire or Dam in Get or Produce classes-must bring written permission from owner.

Nursing mothers may not be accompanied into the ring by their cria.

**Halter Classes:** Age as of Date of Show. Juvenile: 5-12mo. Yearling: 13-24 months. 2-year-old: 25-36months, Adult: over 36 months. Include all ALSA numbers for your llamas.

### **WOOL DESCRIPTIONS:**

Per the 23<sup>rd</sup> Edition of the ALSA Handbook, Part I, Section 1:

**Light:** Minimum body wool, short neck wool, smooth legs.

Medium: moderate to long body wool, minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate leg wool.

**Heavy:** abundant body & neck wool with minimal to abundant leg wool.

**Suri:** Lustrous, cool hand, lack of crimp and minimal loft, locked fiber that drapes over the llamas body. Fibers are grouped in distinctive, defined lock structure.

**Silky:** Fiber exhibits a very soft or silky handle; it may exhibit some wave or crinkle but not crimp. Fiber may exhibit some loft and luster. Guard hair is nearly indiscernible Coverage may vary from light to heavy

Enter your animals in their proper wool divisions Be Aware that suri and silky are wool TYPES where light, medium, and heavy describe COVERAGE. By definition, a light coated suri CAN fall under suri OR light wool. The same can happen with silky animals as well.

#### **FIBER CLASSES**:

There will be no pulling or plucking of Llama fiber. Blunt tipped safety scissors may be used to clip a small sample to attach to the score card as a reference or teaching tool, but only with the handler's express permission. The sample should be the smallest amount possible and taken from an area that will not adversely affect the animal's appearance or damage the prime fleece.

An exhibitor's refusal to allow a sample to be clipped shall in no way affect the judge's score.

Shorn Llama Fleece, Alpaca Fleece and Finished Products:

- Judging begins May 10, 2024 (Saturday).
- Shorn Full Blanket Fleeces must be presented in a clear plastic bag with entry tag.
- Send to Zane Hardy, 16783 230th Ave, Big Rapids, MI 49307 to be received prior to May 9th, 2024.

Hand delivered Fleeces and Finished Products must be at the Fleece Check-In area prior to 8 am May 10, 2024 (Saturday).
