ALSA and ILR-SD Llama Show

Judges: Lauren Wright, Eugen Robinson and Niki Kuklenski

This show is sanctioned by ALSA and ILR-SD. The show will run in accordance to the rules/guidelines in the current edition of the ALSA handbook and the current edition of the ILR Show Division handbook. In the case of any conflicting rules, site rules will prevail. Youth Judging will be run by ALSA guidelines.

All animals must be registered with the ILR for Halter classes. Non ILR registered animals participating in ALSA Performance and Adult Non-Breeder classes must have an ALSA tracking number for the ALSA classes or a an ILR tracking number for the ILR-SD classes.

Copies of pending registration must be presented at check in.

Show entries must be postmarked by August 24, 2023. Show fees MUST be submitted with entries. Late entries will incur a \$25 late fee if postmarked after 8/24/23. Entries received after this date OR without payment will NOT be included in the show program.

Stalls are assigned and tack stalls will be provided. Per facility rules, stalling will open at 12 pm on Friday, Sept 1, 2023 and must be vacated by 10 pm on Sunday, Sept 4, 2023. Any stalling arrangements outside of this time frame will need to be made directly with the facility manager.

Out of state animals MUST have and show a health certificate (at check in) that has been issued within 30 days of the show. The State of Michigan has granted Lamafest a waiver on the 840 microchip requirement as long as all out-of-state animals have a readable microchip. Microchip may be read at registration. Michigan llamas and alpacas do not need a health certificate.

Fun Classes:

Geriatric Llama.....Animal is 10+ years old (as of Sept 1, 2023)

'Golden' Showman.....Handler is 55+ years old (as of Sept 1, 2023)

Performance Classes: An animal can go through a course one time, Master, Advanced, Youth, Novice. Youth may exhibit only one entry per youth class. Youth must show a different animal if entering Master, Advanced, Novice classes. For Master, Advanced and Novice classes there is a limit of three animals per handler per class.
