### Location: In pavilion near Event Office

This class provides an opportunity for you to learn about your llama's fiber characteristics. Please bring your llamas to the judge clean and dry, and preferably without finishing products.

The judge will evaluate the fiber on fineness, uniformity, lock formation, as well as tensile strength and condition. Your llama will also be judged on cleanliness and preparation. Ribbons will be awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place

**You do not need to have a special barrel section of fiber.**

### Age Divisions:

Juvenile - 5 to 12 months

Yearling - 12 to 24 months

Two-Year old - 24 to 36 months

Adult - 36 to 60 months

Mature Adult - 60 months and older

### Fleece Type

**DC** Double Coat – 2 discernible fiber types and textures

**SC** Single Coat – no discernible differences in fiber types and textures

**S** Suri Coat – no crimp, distinct locks, cool, slick handle
