Welcome back to the Mid-Michigan Llama Show! We are having fiber classes again this year. This will also be a dual-sanctioned ALSA and ILR-SD show, double ALSA and double ILR. This is a two-day show. Stalls must be rented. No llamas can be shown out of your trailer. This is a groom show. There is an outside washing area, but it may still be rather chilly in Michigan at the beginning of May. Be sure to watch the weather as we Michiganders know, Michigan is a magical place. It may be 75 ... it may be snowing.

Our show will be held under a closed-sided, covered arena, while all animals are stalled inside a four-sided barn.

Not an ALSA member? ALSA allows exhibitors one “freebie” show. You get to take one free spin around the ALSA block before paying to become a member if you choose. To attend this show, you will need to participate in both ILR & ALSA associations.

Fiber Classes to be held on Friday, May 8th starting at 5 p.m. with our fiber Judge, Joy Bishop-Forshey

There will be an exhibitors' meeting on Saturday, May 9th at 8 a.m.

Showmanship will begin immediately after the exhibitors' meeting. ALSA and ILR Halter Classes run together.

Performance will start at the end of Halter classes on Saturday and will continue at 8 a.m. on Sunday.

These shows are sanctioned by ALSA and ILR. The shows will run according to rules/guidelines in the current edition of ALSA Handbook and the current edition of the ILR Show Division Guidelines. Visit their websites to review the ALSA Handbook and ILR Show Division Guidelines.

Youth Age Division – Youth age as of January 1 of current year.

- Sub Junior – 4 through 6 years old.
- Juniors may not show intact male llamas age 18 months or older
- Youth Junior – 7-11 years (7-year old may show as of their birthday)
- Youth Intermediate – 12-14 years old
- Youth Senior – 15-19 years (When a senior reaches 20th birthday they are ineligible to show in youth division)

Halter Classes – Animals age as of their first day of the show

- Juvenile – 5 months through 12 months
- Yearling – 12 months through 24 months
- 2-year old – 24 months through 36 months
- Adult – 36 months and older

Llama wool description and group classes – Please enter llamas in the appropriate wool division as outlined.

- Suri – Lustrous, cool hand, lack of crimp and minimal loft, locked fiber that drapes over the llama's body
- Silky – Very soft or silky handle, may be straight or have some wave or crinkle but not crimp
- Classic – Abundant guard hair visible on the body and neck of the animal, with short and minimal "downy" undercoat, minimal fleece on legs/head
- Light – Minimal body wool, short neck wool with smooth legs
- Medium – Moderate to long body wool, minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate leg wool.
- Heavy – Abundant body and neck wool with minimal to abundant leg wool (leg wool at least to knee and hock)
- Produce of Dam – Two offspring by the same dam, either sex, and produce may represent the same sire. Produce must be shown in appropriate halter class.
- Get of Sire – Three offspring by the same sire, either sex, by at least two different dams. All "Get" must be shown in appropriate halter class.
If you do not own the dam or sire, bring written permission from the owner for you to show in Produce of Dam or Get of Sire.

Performance Classes

- An animal can only go through a course one time, Youth, Novice, Advanced or Master. In youth showmanship, any animal may be used. To qualify for Youth Performance Champion, the youth must show in Obstacle, PR and Pack, and MUST USE THE SAME ANIMAL in all three classes. Youth must show a different animal if entering Novice, Advanced or Master classes.
