SAVE GEORGIA'S 2024 ELECTION USE HAND MARKED, HAND COUNTED PAPER BALLOTS

Dear Rep.

I am one of thousands of Georgia voters, including many here in your district, who no longer trust voting on the "black box" Dominion voting system because it is inaccurate (DeKalb County Michelle Long-Spears), insecure (the Halderman Report), illegal (per Judge Amy Totenberg), unverifiable to the voter and it is an unnecessary financial burden on the counties. For example:

- 1. Our voting system is unverifiable to voters because it counts the QR code Not the human readable text.
- 2. A U.S. District Court found the voting system's unverifiability <u>violates two Georgia laws</u>. [pages 81-82]
- 3. The system could not produce accurate results for Coffee Co. in 2020 and it <u>declared</u> the wrong winners in the 2022 DeKalb District 2 Commission race.
- 4. The recently unsealed <u>Halderman Security Analysis</u> found the system was not designed, engineered or tested properly for election security and it cannot be retrofitted for security.

The Secretary of State's <u>rebuttal to the MITRE report</u> has been <u>ridiculed by 29 experts</u> as "dangerous" and "ridiculous". Nevertheless, Raffensperger has continued conducting secretly counted elections with sealed ballots even for his own unverifiable 2022 primary.

The Legislature MUST call a special session to protect the 2024 election with secure hand marked paper ballots, publicly hand counted with full audits and ballots publicly available immediately after the election. Several bills have already been introduced to accomplish most of these critical objectives.

The Constitution grants all power to conduct elections to the legislature, so a simple majority vote is all that is needed to call for a special session on elections. I urge you to act now to save Georgia's 2024 election. We are out of time.
