Rules to remember: Please keep all shots in the Berm, no skeet, trap, explosive targets or hand thrown items. We have been seeing a lot of shot gun shells! Shot guns to be sighted in with SLUGS ONLY, and within 25 yds of the berm. No shooting before 8:00AM Monday thru Saturday and no Shooting before 9:00am on Sunday.***Remember shooting needs to cease a ½ hour before sunset. Be sure and fly the Red Flag from the red box on the Flag Pole.
