Rules to remember: Please keep all shots in the Berm, no skeet, trap, explosive targets or hand thrown items. Shot guns to be sighted in with SLUGS only and within 25 yds of the berm. No shooting before 8:00AM Monday thru Saturday and no Shooting before 9:00am on Sunday. Be sure and fly the Red Flag in the red box on the Flag Pole. Remember shooting needs to cease a ½ hour before sunset. Be Safe and have a good Day. Thank you.

Building Target Frame instructions have been posted on the website Firearms page for you to make and use at the Rifle range when practicing. Follow the measurements and you should be good to go.
