**Rifle and Pistol:** The warmer weather is here. Please lend a hand cleaning up these ranges when you are using them. We are planning some improvements soon to both the Rifle and Pistol Ranges.

Rules to remember: Please keep all shots in the Berm, no skeet, trap, explosive targets or hand thrown items. We have been seeing a lot of shot gun shells! NO SHOTSHELLS ALLOWED!! Shot guns to be sighted in with SLUGS ONLY, and within 25 yds of the berm. No shooting before 8:00AM Monday thru Saturday and no Shooting before 9:00am on Sunday.\*\*\*Remember shooting needs to cease a ½ hour before sunset.

Be sure and fly the Red Flag from the red box on the Flag Pole.
