No shooting before 8:00AM Monday thru Saturday and no Shooting before 9:00am on Sunday. Be sure and fly the Red Flag in the red box on the Flag Pole. Remember shooting needs to cease a ½ hour before sunset. Be Safe and have a good Day. Thank you.
