WHAT IS A CLUB DEVELOPMENT CENTER (CDC) PROGRAM?

In order to fully understand the programs offered to children born between 2022 and 2014, the Brossard Soccer Association would like to inform parents/guardians of the following information:

The Club Development Center (CDC) programs represent the introductory and continuing development stages for age groups born between 2022 and 2014. Various options are available in winter for players who want to participate in soccer once a week (CDC 1) to players who want to develop to their full potential with two activities per week (CDC 2).

What is the difference between a Club Development Center (CDC) and the local house league?

The CDC is a much more structured program than the local house league. Players who wish to join this program will have qualified coaches and a more rigorous training structure..

The **LOCAL HOUSE LEAGUE** is a program for players who simply want to play games every week.
