Work For Play

Wednesdays from 5:00-5:45pm

\$200 per 6 week session

This class focuses on building and using play drive as a form of reinforcement. If you struggle with engagement with a toy, or want to harness your dog's play drive for work, this is a great class for you.

Dogs work individually in this class- dogs must be able to wait in vehicles for their turn. Open to dog-reactive dogs.

Basic Manners

Wednesdays from 6:00-6:45pm

\$200 per 6 week session- week 1 will be a no dog orientation

This is not your typical basic obedience class- this class focuses on practical solutions to every day issues in the home and daycare setting. This includes waiting at the door, counter surfing, polite greetings, and more. This is class for people who want real solutions to real issues.

Dogs work simultaneously in this class- not open to reactive dogs.

Tricks- Mixed Level

Wednesdays from 7:00-8:00pm

\$200 per 6 week session- week 1 will be a no dog orientation

This class is for anyone who is looking to challenge themselves and their dog mentally and physically with tricks. This is a mixed level class- beginners will learn the basic tools needed as a foundation for all future training, and more advanced students will progress through a variety of tricks- these might include spin, sit pretty, roll over, or even more complex behaviors. If your dog loves to learn and you love to show off at parties, this is the class for you.
