THE SCROLL OF THE FOG

**Clearing the Atmosphere of Confusion, Perception Distortion,
and Spiritual Misdirection**

The Fog of This Age

There is a fog that has settled over the earth — not a weather pattern,
but a spiritual atmosphere.

It clouds perception, manipulates truth, and scrambles discernment.
This fog is engineered through fear, media, religious control, and un-
seen powers that whisper lies into the cracks of trauma. It isn't ran-
dom. It's woven with intention — a distortion field meant to replace
clarity with chaos and confidence with doubt.

The fog is thickest where truth is rising. It surrounds the path just
before breakthrough. And many mistake it for God's silence, when in

What Was Distorted

- Discernment was replaced with emotional reaction and spiritual guesswork.
- Authority was given to outside voices — religious figures, influencers, systems — instead of Christ within.
- Confusion was normalized as a test from God, rather than a sign of interference.
- Trauma was spiritualized rather than healed.
- Dreams and signs were over-relied on, while intimacy with Christ was neglected.
- The fog became familiar — and many stopped questioning it.

What Was Lost

- The clarity of communion with Christ's voice — personal, daily, and unmistakable.
- The quiet confidence of knowing truth from within.
- The ability to distinguish between the Spirit of God and the voices of fear, self, or spirits of control.

- The sacred stillness where truth is revealed.
- The authority to command confusion to leave — instead of adapting to it.

What Must Be Restored

We must clear the fog by anchoring to what is eternal: Christ within, not the chaos without. Discernment is not a gift for the few — it is the birthright of every son and daughter of God. But it must be trained, restored, and wielded.

How to Discern the True Voice

1. Ask Jesus Directly

We live in a world of voices: pastors, prophets, algorithms, influencers, inner critics, ancestral wounds, and spirits disguised as light. The veil between heaven and earth has thinned — but so has the clarity between what is true and what is counterfeit.

Not every supernatural voice is God. Not every light is holy. And not every “feeling” is divine.

The veil was torn when Christ died (Matthew 27:51), but many still operate behind false veils — religious systems, channeling spirits, and

“intuition” masked as truth. This scroll is a call to discern the voice of Jesus clearly again.

What Was Distorted

- The idea that God is hard to hear — when He said His sheep *do* hear His voice.
- Emotionalism, mysticism, and counterfeit light replaced intimacy with the Living Word.
- Spiritual voices were accepted without testing the source.
- People sought “the voice” through altered states, not through Christ.
- Many began following signs and synchronicities instead of the Shepherd.

What Was Lost

- The simplicity of hearing Jesus in stillness.
- Trust in the indwelling Holy Spirit as teacher and guide.
- Confidence in one’s ability to discern without needing intermediaries.
- The daily practice of hearing and obeying truth through love, not fear.

- Awareness that true authority flows from the voice of Christ, not spiritual theatrics.

What Must Be Restored

We must return to the clarity of communion — not performance, not spiritual noise, but a true relationship with the risen Christ. God's voice is not a riddle or a guessing game. It is the language of love, anchored in the Word and confirmed by peace.

How to Discern the True Voice

1. Ask Jesus Directly

Not a feeling. Not a vague message. Not someone else.

Ask: "Jesus Christ, is this You?"

2. Anchor to the Word, Not Just Words

The voice of God will never contradict the nature of Jesus.

Peace. Truth. Clarity. Love. Courage.

3. Use Your Authority
