The flame of God **always** produces peace, clarity, humility, and alignment.

False light produces anxiety, confusion, pride, and spiritual addiction.

This is why many follow deception — because it *feels good*.

But the truth doesn't just feel good.

It **sets you free**.

If you've followed false light — you're not damned. You were hungry.

If you've spoken from it — you're not disqualified. You were still
learning.

But now you know.
