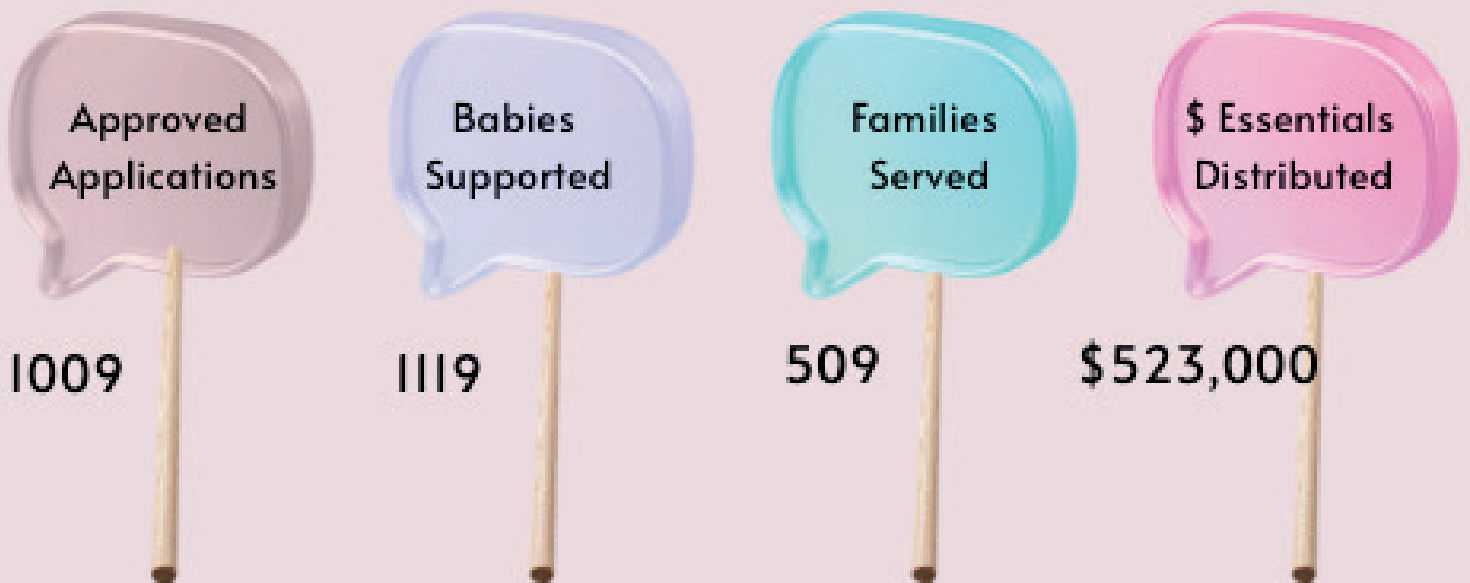
Dear Friend,

As we welcome 2026, Little Miracles would like to pause and reflect on an extraordinary year made possible by a deeply caring community of generous donors, dedicated volunteers, community partners, and trusted friends.

Because of supporters like you—and the commitment of more than 300 volunteers—2025 was a year of meaningful impact, as families across our community were met with compassion, dignity, and practical support at a time when providing for their babies felt especially difficult.

2025 IMPACT AT A GLANCE



Now serving 500+ families annually

In 2025, Little Miracles was supported entirely through private philanthropy and community generosity. Fundraising represented the largest share of our funding and was driven by two primary events: our Miracle Mom Matching Campaign, which raised more than \$63,000 with the help of a generous 50% match from Community Health & Education Foundation, and Trinity Lutheran Church's festive Oktoberfest, which brought in over \$14,000 in support of local families. Corporate and foundation grants, along with individual donations, provided critical, reliable support throughout the year, allowing us to meet growing demand for baby essentials across the Tri-Valley. Notably, Little Miracles received no state or government funding in 2025, meaning our impact was made possible entirely by the compassion and commitment of our community.

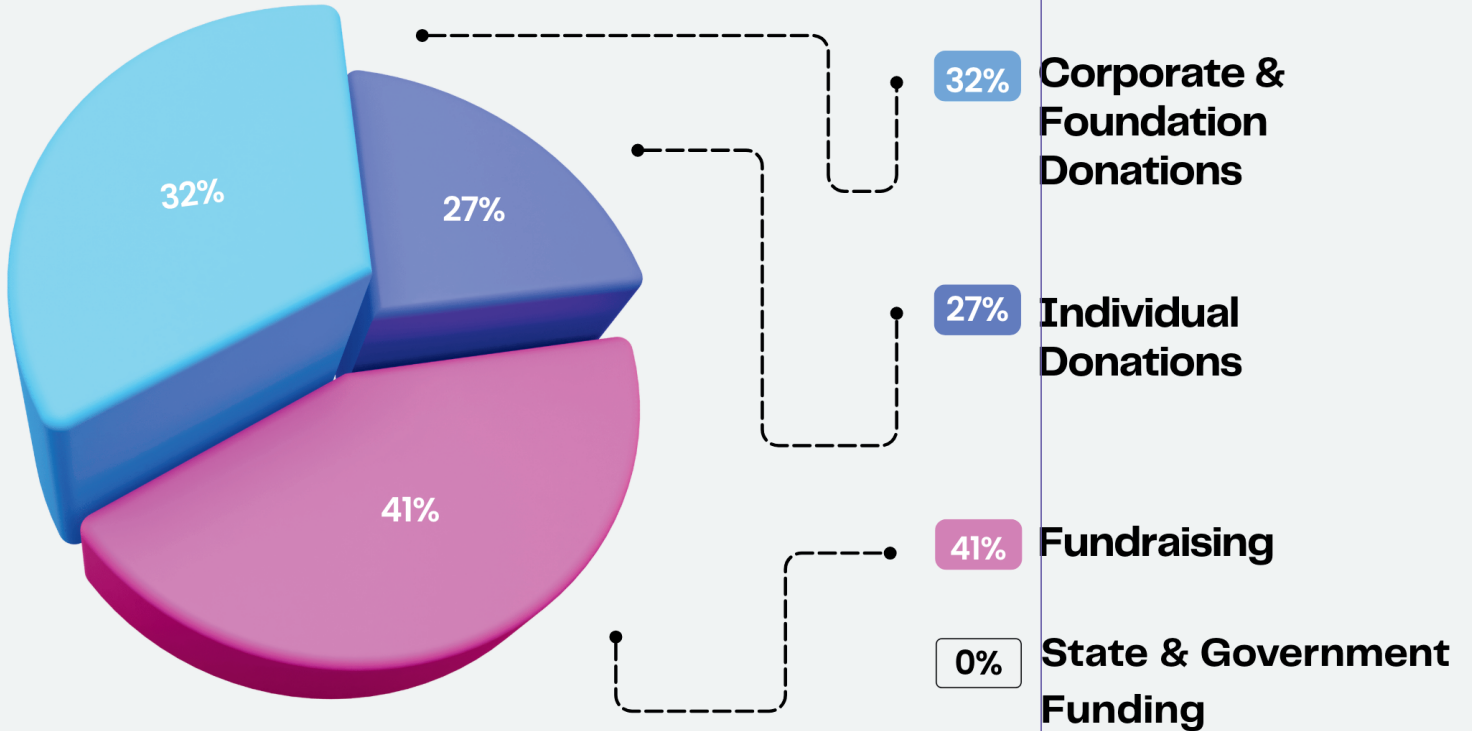
