


Providing Baby Essentials That Every Child Deserves

Thanks to your kindness and commitment, we were able to achieve incredible milestones in 2024, increasing the number of families helped by providing much-needed assistance to families in our Tri-Valley community.

2024 AMAZING IMPACT!



- 1065 Baby Orders: Each baby order, averaging a value of \$488, brought essential supplies to families, ensuring their little ones had the care and resources they needed to thrive. This number represents an incredible 122% increase over 2023!
- 250 Volunteers: Our growing network of compassionate individuals, affectionately referred to as our "Miracle Crew" donated their time and energy to ensure every order was packed with care and distributed with love.
- \$86,000 raised through Fundraising events held by Real Estate Alliance of Livermore, Heffernan Insurance Foundation, Trinity Lutheran Church and Kottinger Barn Holiday Event.
- 10 community grants: We received \$24,000 in community grant funding from generous organizations, churches, and businesses, enabling us to extend our reach and provide even more support.

Born and raised in the Bay Area, Andrea has made Dublin her family's home since moving from Fremont in 2017. As a dedicated caregiver through the IHSS (In Home Support Services) program since 2012, she has dedicated her life to her oldest son with Autism, all while raising two younger children. Despite the challenges of financial hardships, her son's Autism-related behaviors, and her own health struggles, she continues to press forward with courage and determination.

Being diagnosed with spinal stenosis after her youngest child was born changed her life dramatically. Maneuvering through life with physical limitations and caring for a toddler has tested Andrea physically and emotionally. Yet, her unwavering desire for her children to thrive and experience joy in a complex world keeps her moving forward. Andrea resolved not to let depression or hardship hold her back from "being the best version of myself that God has called me to be."

Andrea first heard of Little Miracles from her social worker. Within days of reaching out for help, Little Miracles loaded her car with much appreciated necessities, bath toiletries, clothing, books, blankets, toys, and a car seat.

"I am incredibly grateful, especially since these are not inexpensive items, and with our current financial challenges, this support has been a true blessing."

Andrea recalls the kindness shown to her and her children during her visit, "everyone at Little Miracles was so welcoming and made us feel at ease, even allowing our daughter to enjoy picking out additional items."
