Q: How do I get copies of military discharge documents?

A: The Grundy County Veterans Assistance Commission can help you with this process, please contact us at 815-941-3152 for assistance or with general questions about military documents.

Military personnel records can include DD 214s/Separation Documents, service personnel records found within the Official Military Personnel File (OMPF), and service related medical records. Military personnel records can be used for proving military service or as a valuable tool in genealogical research.

The information you will need to request military documents includes:

For a deceased veteran a copy of the veteran's death certificate is required.
